Dear Dr. Berg:

I have completed review of the above referenced case file to determine if case closure is warranted at this time.

When a 750 gallon fuel underground storage tank (UST) was removed in May 1990, hydrocarbon-impacted soil was identified. overexcavation removed additional contaminated soil. Confirmatory soil samples identified residual contamination of up to 1,300 parts per million total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (ppm TPHg) and 1.5 ppm benzene in soil.

Piezometers were installed to determine if the fuel release had impacted groundwater quality. Analytical results suggest that groundwater contamination exists, but is limited to the immediate vicinity of the former UST.

Before case closure is recommended a risk management plan is required which should address the following:

- 1. identify all potential receptors who/which may be impacted by residual hydrocarbons in soil and groundwater, if any; and,
- methods to mitigate risk during earth moving activities, trenching, etc, especially to construction workers.


