The wells were abandoned on May 20, 1996 under permit with the Zone 7 Water Agency (permit no. 96222). Two of the monitoring wells were located along the parking lanes of San Pablo Avenue. Abandonment of these wells required an encroachment permit from CAL-TRANS (permit no. 0496-NSV-0940). Special abandonment procedures of the wellheads were completed according to CAL-TRANS requirements and a, "notice of completion", post card was submitted (transmitted by the City of Emeryville Redevelopment Agency). Lastly, an encroachment permit was obtained from the City of Emeryville for the abandonment of two wells located on the sidewalk and road of 43<sup>rd</sup> Street.
