EMPTY DRUM CERTIFICATION

I hereby certify that these drums are "empty" as that term is defined in the national Environmental Protection Agency regulations, 40 CFR 261.7, and that they have been properly prepared for transportation under the regulations of the U.S. Dept. of Transportation, 49 CFR 173.29**.

*With regard to most regulated residues, EPA's 40 CFR 261.7 states, "A container is empty if;
(1) All wastes have been removed that can be removed using practices commonly employed to remove materials from that type of container, e.g. pouring, pumping, and
(2) No more than 2.5 centimeters (one inch) of residue in the bottom of the container.

**DOT's 49 CFR 173.29 states that all openings on the empty container must be closed, and that all markings and labels must be in place as if the drum were full of its original contents. A DOT shipping paper is not required for transportation of a empty drum for reconditioning via contract or private carrier. DOT placarding is not required for vehicles carrying empty containers.

For residues of products specifically specified in 40 CFR 261.32 (E), the container is empty only, if the container has been triple rinsed using a solvent capable of removing, or has been cleaned by another method shown capable of equivalent removal."
