The Alameda County Department of Environmental Health, Environmental Protection Division has recently received concurrence from the Regional Water Quality Control Board regarding this office determination that no further action is required concerning the removal of three underground storage tanks (1 -4,000 gallon gasoline, 1 - 500 gallon gasoline and 1 - 500 gallon diesel) at the referenced site.

Please be advised that the three groundwater monitoring wells (MW-1, MW-2 and MW-3) at the site must be properly decommissioned before our agency will issue the **Remedial Action Completion Certification** (closure letter) for the subject site. A report must be submitted documenting the abandonment of the monitoring wells.

Additionally, you will need to notify this office 72 hours in advance of the well abandonment field activities.

If your cleanup effort has already started and was delayed, you must resume the expenditure of funds to ensure that your cleanup is proceeding in an expeditious manner. You are reminded that you must comply with all regulatory agency time schedules and requirements. We constantly review the status of all active claims, and failure to proceed with due diligence will be grounds for withdrawal of this Letter of Commitment.

You should read the terms and conditions listed in the Letter of Commitment. Also attached you will find:

- A "Reimbursement Request Instructions" package. You should retain this package for future reimbursement requests. Among other information, the package includes instructions for completion of the "Reimbursement Request" form and the "Spreadsheet". These instructions must be followed when seeking reimbursement for corrective action costs incurred after January 1, 1988. Included in these instructions are samples of Reimbursement Request forms and completed Spreadsheets. Within the package also included are:

I have completed review of BSK's January 1994 First Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring report for the above referenced site. The existing three monitoring wells have been sampled for two consecutive quarters.

Analysis for total lead may be eliminated in future sampling episodes. Because all the wells appear to be downgradient from the former UST pit, analysis of hydrocarbon constituents must be performed for all water samples collected. After two more sampling quarters, this site will be evaluated for case closure.




