He was not aware that this soil was being excavated as was stated by Mr. Framstad.

Soil was not further excavated from tank pit after initial soil samples collected from pit. The tank pit was backfilled. It is unknown at what depth Sample #2 was collected from under the 125 gallon tank in 1991. Mr. Faccor stated that this well was in such bad condition, that house it was in pieces.

Ms. McWhinney asked if soil and ground water samples had to be analyzed for the parameters listed under "Unknown Tanks" in the Tri-Valley Regional Guidelines. The tank that was thought to have contained an unknown substance was stated to have contained gasoline by Steve McKinley, at Alameda Fire Dept. Ms. Stein stated that if she had adequate documentation showing that the tank only contained gasoline, then it would be okay not to analyze for all the "Unknown Tank" parameters. However, Ms. Stein stated that if it is uncertain whether this gasoline was leaded or unleaded, then all environmental soil and ground water samples need to be analyzed for total lead!

Mr. Franssted does not think an Unquestioned Release Report was ever filled out. Mr. Franssted will be sent a form to fill out and send back to Alameda County.

All the excavated soil from the tank pit has been aerated on site since the tank pull. The soil is being aerated at the southwest corner of the property, approximately 80 - 100 yards from where people golf. Mr. Franssted will try and send me a copy of a figure showing the location of soil aeration.

Mr. Franssted was asked if he knew whether BAAQMD was informed of the soil aeration at the site. Mr. Franssted stated that he did not know and told me to ask Gary Zaccor of Zaccor Corporation (consultant to RP).

Ms. MaWhinney asked if samples could only be analyzed for one round of sampling. Ms. Shin stated that, after the first round of sampling, analysis would not have to be performed for those constituents showing N.D., excluding TPH and BTEX ofcourse.

Also, Ms. MaWhinney wanted to know if a soil boring still had to be conducted to the north of the excavation pit, since she located the results of a soil sample collected from MW-1, located immediately north of the tank pit, and it showed Non Detect for contaminants. It was decided that a soil sample should still be collected from the north end of the tank pit, because in 1991, five years after the soil sample was collected from MW-1, soil samples collected from the northern wall of the tank pit identified unacceptable concentrations of hydrocarbons.
