Mr. Foster feels ~~technically~~ that ~~plume~~ gw should be NO SW on County prop. so this would be the best location - a hydro punch study he feels is overkill. Mr. Duffman stated that soil samples were collected from Wells MW-1 and MW-4 at 10 & 14' bgs ~~was~~ during well installation & they had gotten hits. My concern is that water level has greatly risen in last gully sampling event & may be picking up contamination leached onto soil in shallower depths.

Mr. Palmer stated that the pump tests conducted for the current groundwater extraction system at the above site showed that groundwater contaminants couldn't be migrating off site and into the canal. Mr. Palmer stated that he could submit pump test results to his office in the form of a summary report, if his client approved the cost for the preparation. Ms Shin stated that she would send ~~me~~ the R.P. a letter requesting that info.

Also, Jim Rubens stated that he thought that the site was ready for closure even though monitoring wells RW-1 and MW-2 are still detecting concentrations of TPH and benzene over acceptable levels. Mr. ^{Rubens} Palmer stated that due to the clays at the site, their client may have to operate the extraction system for another 100 years before they're able to get the concentrations down to acceptable ^{levels} concentrations. Mr. Vonthaden requested that MW-8 on site be switched to annual monitoring since it has sampled Non Detect for four quarters. Ms. Shin told him to make that request through a letter, and said that it appears to be okay to do so.

Mr. Vonthaden also stated that the reason a well has not been placed downgradient of MW-2 and RW-1, both "Hot", is due to a canal/slough that runs parallel and adjacent to the southern boundary of the property. He stated that during the past pump test that canal water was actually drawn into the extraction well which proved that contaminants were not migrating into the canal. Additionally, he stated that the canal water was sampled in the past & came up Non Detect.

Well MW-3 used to be located where the extraction well, RW-1, is currently located.
