Workplan for Soil Contamination Investigation Fuel Storage Tanks at 848 Blossom Way Hayward California

Per your request, please find enclosed a workplan for soil contamination investigation at the subject site. A representative of this firm discussed this site with you on Monday, March 24, 1991. The project site is located on the northside of Blossom Way in Hayward, California.

- 1. Review County Regulations with regards to Underground Storage Tanks and their disposal. We will also review all the necessary documentation on the tanks made available to us by Mr. George Heywood.
- 2. Drill two exploratory borings in the areas where the two tanks were buried. The borings will be drilled to such depths as will be deemed necessary. The boring(s) will be logged by an engineer/engineering geologist on our staff who will obtain samples for laboratory testing. The

samples will be stored in ice chest and taken to a State Certified Chemical Laboratory.

- 3. Perform the necessary chemical and mechanical testing on the samples obtained to determine the level of contamination.
  - 4. Provide recommendations for disposal of the soils if found contaminated.
- 5. Summarize our findings and recommendations in a written report.
