I spoke with Bruce Hageman today regarding Adobe Plaza. I requested the following information:

- ① a discussion of why the MW-2 was ~~a~~ sampled and analyzed on two different occasions;
- ② a technical explanation from NET Pacific Laboratories regarding the second round of MW-2 sample analyses which indicates the detection limits raised several points, and up to an order-of-magnitude.

Upon this agency's satisfaction of these items, I would concur with their recommendation for  $1/4$  monitoring the first year.
