VII. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS, DATA, ETC.

A 500 gallon gasoline UST was removed on Feb 14, 1991. Water was noted in the pit, but believed to be from a leaking water pipe. A side wall soil sample collected at 8' depth did not detect TPH-G or BTEX. A grab ground water sample collected (without prior purging) detected 910 ppb TPH-G, 17, 13, 18, and 45 ppb BTEX, respectively.

Three monitoring wells were proposed (MW-1, 2, and 3). However, drilling of well MW-2 was abandoned after two attempts encountered several unreported underground pipes.

Well MW-1 was installed south of, and well MW-3 was installed north of the former tank location. Both wells were drilled to approximately 30' depth, after encountering groundwater at approximately 20' depth. Soil samples collected at 10, and 15 or 20' depths did not detect TPH-G or BTEX. groundwater from wells MW-1 and MW-3 did not detect hydrocarbon constituents.

It appears water noted in the pit at the time of UST removal was from a leaking water pipe. The fuel release at this site does not appear to have impacted groundwater. An unknown quantity of contaminated stockpile soil from the tank removal was disposed at Keller Canyon, in Pittsburg. Continued groundwater sampling is not warranted.

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
