The final closure letter (Remedial Action Completion Certification) will be issued by this office after the wells have been properly decommissioned.



- Clean out all bridged or poorly compacted materials to the bottom of the well. 1.
- Pressure grout the casing to 2 feet below finished grade or original ground, whichever 2. is the lower elevation.
- Remove casing, seal and gravel pack to 2 feet below finished grade or original ground, 3. whichever is the lower elevation.
- After the seal has set, backfill the remaining hole with compacted material. 4.

These destruction requirements as proposed by Robert Kitchen of Robert B. Kitchen & Associates meet or exceed Zone 7 minimum requirements.

The Alameda County Department of Environmental Health, Environmental Protection Division has recently received concurrence from the Regional Water Quality Control Board regarding this office determination that no further action is required concerning the removal of two underground storage tanks (6,000 gallon gasoline and 1,000 gallon diesel) on March 9, 1990 at the above referenced site.

Please be advised that the four groundwater monitoring wells (MW-1, MW-2, MW-3 and MW-4) at the site must be properly decommissioned before our agency will issue the "Remedial Action Completion Certification" (closure letter) for the subject site. A report must be submitted documenting the abandonment of the monitoring wells. Additionally, you will need to notify this office 72 hours in advance of the well abandonment field activities.
