The Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACHD) has submitted letters which recommend closure for your site involving the removal of two 10,000 gallon petroleum fuel oil tanks and one 750 gallon diesel tank. Regional Board staff have reviewed the file for your site and concur with this recommendation. Therefore based on the available information for the above site, it appears that further investigation and cleanup of petroleum hydrocarbons are not necessary. Further work could be required if conditions change or a water quality threat is discovered at the site.
