

Dear Mr. Eplin:

The Alameda County Department of Environmental Health has submitted a report which summarizes the investigation of hydrocarbon pollution resulting from leaks associated with a 1000 gallon underground storage tank at the above mentioned site, and recommends that the case be closed. The Regional Board staff reviewed the report and concur with the recommendation. Therefore, based on the available information for the above site, it appears that further investigation and cleanup of the hydrocarbon pollution is not necessary at this time. However, further work may be required if conditions change or a water quality threat is discovered at the site.
