

Pursuant to your request for a site safty plan, as follows is an outline of what procedures will be followed.

We will maintain a gas tech combustible gas detector (sniffer) on the job site from begining to end. All workmen have been trained for safty procedure for tank removal. All workmen will be required to have protective boots, protective gloves and level C protective clothing will be provided on job site at all times. Hard hats and necessary fire extingishers will be at job site at all times. We do not anticipate any safty risks at the site. If any such risks arise, the problem will be dealt with at that time. In the event that high levels of combustible materials or hazardous materials are encountered, our workmen will be removed from the site and your office will be notified for further action. The site will be fenced off and barricaded for security and safty. Robert L. Stevens will be responsible for site safty. All rules will be followed as per specified in 29CFR 1910 120 (1) (2) (1) for Workmen Protection and Safty. In the event of a medical emergency, Kaiser Permanente of Hayward will be used, as all personel are covered by a Kaiser plan. All rules for decontamination will be adhered to, if contamination is present. All rules and regulations per your closure plan will be followed.

No personnel will be allowed in the excavation below 5' depth Sincerely

Dear Mr. Eplin:

On May 30, 1990, you were issued a Final Notice of Violation regarding improper closure of an underground storage tank on your premises. On July 6 this office received a tank closure plan prepared by R. L. Stevens Co. for your site. I reviewed the document and on July 9, telephoned Robert Stevens to inform him that additional information would be required to complete the site safety plan. The specific points we discussed were:

- 1. On site safety training for personnel involved with the tank removal
- 2. The need for a description of specific safety risks expected to be encountered onsite and the measures to be taken to minimize these risks (i.e., explosion, fire, chemical, heavy equipment, confined space, and excavation hazards)
- 3. Site control and security measures (keeping unauthorized personnel away from the work area)
- 4. The specific medical facility to be utilized in case of an exposure or accident at the site
- 5. Decontamination procedures in the case of an exposure to petrochemicals

Mr. Stevens stated that he would complete the site safety plan and forward it to this office.

By October 25, 1990, as I had not received the requested information from R. L. Stevens, I contacted his office again. He agreed to forward an addendum to the closure plan by October 31, 1990. To date, I have not received any additional documents. The completed site safety plan must be submitted to this office no later than November 20, 1990. ### FINAL NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Eplin:

On August 8, 1989 it was noted that you have an underground storage tank for gasoline located at the 22389 parcel of your auto body lot. You were sent a Notice of Violation concerning the tank dated August 9, 1989 followed by a second Notice of Violation on November 7, 1989. On August 21, 1989 you stated to Senior Hazardous Materials Specialist Tom Peacock that the tank had been filled with sand about 4 years ago and is still in place. In January of 1990 you requested an underground tank closure plan and were sent one by Tom Peacock on 1/29/90.

Please submit to this office, by June 15, 1990, the completed closure plan and all documents pertaining to your inactivation of the tank. Especially needed are:

- 1. Records of Fire Department approval for the action.
- 2. Laboratory analysis of rinsates, soil, or borings.
- 3. Permits or any correspondence regarding the action.
- 4. The date of the tank filling.

Please note that 25299(a) of the California Health and Safety Code states that any operator of an underground storage tank is liable for a civil penalty of not less than five hundred dollars or more than five thousand dollars per day for (5) failing to properly close an underground storage tank, as required by section 25298. Also, (b) has the same penalty for abandonment or improper closure of any underground storage tank. This regulation has been in effect since 1984 so you may be required to perform further investigations or actions concerning this matter.
