11/1/95 (cont....) is a tenant at 1081 D Eastshore currently. Williams and Lane last operated the USTs in the 1970s, however, Wilanco owned this company, so Wilanco as prop. owners would be the sole R.P. The USTs ~~are~~ were located closest to 1081 Eastshore.

11/2/95 John Piggott - Will send me map w/ locations of former tanks relative to specific addresses. He may decide to change address to 1081 to 1085 Eastshore if it is more accurate.

11/8/95 After reviewing over info provided by John Piggott of Wilanco, it was decided to change address of COP site to 1081-1085 Eastshore Hwy (at John Piggott's request). Sierra Detroit Diesel was a former tenant of 1081 Eastshore, but the tanks were owned by Wilanco.

8/18/95

Gary Lowe, H₂O GEOL, 510 373-9211

Requested that Mr. Lowe fax a copy of well construction info & boring logs, showing DTWs, for the ~~to~~ existing wells that will be monitored: MW-K, MW-L, and MW-U. I reminded him that if water table is observed to be shallower than 5' bgs during drilling, that the well screens should account for that if sufficient seal materials are possible.

9/14/95

John Piggott - called & stated that one whole block used to be designated as 1077 Eastshore, but now his site is designated 1081 Eastshore Highway. He will submit documentation showing this change (which may require us to change our database).

9/14/95

Called County assessor's office. They claimed that there was no listing for 1081 Eastshore Hwy.

9/14/95

Called Mr. Piggott back and asked him to contact assessor's office & include info from assessor's office in documentation.

11/1/95

John Piggott, 510-525-3750 - Mr. Piggott stated that Sierra Detroit Diesel was a former tenant that occupied from 1073 to 1085 Eastshore Hwy. The Sierra never used the six underground storage tanks. Remco is the current tenant at 1077 Eastshore. The six USTs were removed from 1081 Eastshore. Cabello Bros.

PHONE LOG (1077 Eastshore)

5/17/95 I met w/ Mr Piggott. Wilanco is a owner-man
owned company. Mr. Piggott already placed wells on
his property due to litigation w/ neighboring ACCASO
site. The tanks were not in use since the late 70's.
At that time, the tanks were emptied & filled w/ H₂O.
Williams & Lane were the last ones to operate the tanks,
but that company is no longer in existence. Mr Piggott
intends to use one existing well to monitor Tank Ret #1
& to install a well downgradient of Tank Ret #2. He
requested an additional 30 days to submit a work plan,
so the work plan is now due by Aug 15 '95.
