Based on our telephone conversation this afternoon, we have included the following revisions to our Work Plan for performing a limited site investigation at the Curoco Steel Systems Facility located at 536 Cleveland Avenue in Albany, California ("the Site").

Two grab groundwater samples will be collected from a total of two hydropunch locations west (downgradient) of the former UST at the Site. The proposed hydropunch location closest to the Southern Pacific railroad tracks will be relocated approximately 25 feet north of the existing proposed location (see Figure 2).

A boring will initially be drilled to establish the approximate depth of the groundwater table. The hollow diameter steel casing containing a perforated PVC screen at the bottom of the casing will be advanced to approximately one foot below the groundwater surface. The casing will then be retracted approximately 18 inches to screen across the groundwater surface and allow infiltration of groundwater.
