Mr. Bennett also said the recent GW sampling failed to turn up any detectable contaminants.

Brian Owen of IT Corp called me back today. He informed me of the condition of the subject well and development activities that occurred last week. He was not there during well development; however, he was able to summarize the observations of the sampling crew, as follows:

- 1) Well has a Christy box w/ hex key closure and gasket. The technicians feel there was dirt on the seal ~~on~~ which prevent a tight closure. Water was "welled" into the Christy box, perhaps from surface runoff. There was no lock on the well cap, although it seemed sealed. Mr. Owen suggested to Jim Craig that a lock be installed.
- 2) During well development, 5 gals (~5 well volume) were removed. The GW started clear, and became more turbid as more GW was removed. The recharge rate is slow, but appears steady.
- 3) Sampling is scheduled for today.

I FAXED a copy of the 12/14/91 correspondence to Mr. Owen for reference. We discussed sample analyses methods.

- Jim Craig of C.U. Autohaus called today. He said when IT Corp. was out to develop the well, there wasn't enough GW to allow development. I mentioned that potable water can be added to such wells to aid development, provide this is cleared through Zone 7 first. I mentioned to Jim that I'd previously brought this to Paul Drakowicz's attention when he and I spoke the week of May 12. Jim ~~said~~ said that IT Corp was going to "allow the well to sit a few days".
- Jim further said that the IT Corp sampling crew told him that the well was constructed in such a way as to allow surface runoff to enter the well. I told Craig that without the well construction drawings in hand (ie, no report submitted yet), it was not possible for me to know what the problem was. I asked that he have the IT Corp folks contact me regarding these issues.

I spoke (after today w/ Paul) of D+D management. He said the well was installed in mid March 1991. No G.W. samples were collected at that time. He said this was because Mr. Craig requested that he (Craig) be allowed to coordinate through IT Corp directly in order to save \$\$\$. The wells not developed either. Mr. Dzakowicz said that the well was "dry", although some dampness was observed from cuttings brought from the shallow bedrock during advancement of the boring. Mr. Dzakowicz said the geologist doubted at that time that the screened sediments would produce water, even, according to Mr. Dzakowicz, in light of the fact that G.W. was actively flowing into the UST pit during closure. Mr. Dzakowicz said he understood that IT Corp was to develop the well Friday and sample Monday (5/17, 5/20 respectively).

He said that he would send a brief chronology about what ~~had~~ had occurred to date. He also said that a report should follow w/in a couple ~~days~~ weeks after sampling.

I spoke w/ Paul Drakowic of D&D Magnet Consultants re: the field work assoc. with the PSA at this site. The Dec. 14, 1990 correspondence from this office gave 45 days, or Jan 31, 1991, to initiate field work. Mr. Drakowic said he just got a copy of the Dec. 14 ~ 2 weeks ago. No Zone 7 permits have been applied for yet. The drifters have not been scheduled.

I told him I was discouraged that there is a lack of communication ^{with} ~~to~~ this Dept., and that he need be up front if problems occur so that extensions can be granted, if required.

I closed the conversation by telling him that field work must begin w/in 2 weeks.

I spoke w/ Jim Craig today, questioning him about the work which reportedly occurred in Feb 1991 and the report which has not been submitted. Mr. Craig says he "assumed" we got a copy of the report and that he was waiting for some direction from this office. He said that he got a copy of the report ~10 days after the well was installed. I requested a copy.

No water samples were collected, apparently. He said the well was "dry" when first installed. He doesn't know if it was ever developed. He said that water was observed in the well some days or weeks later, but no samples were collected. Why?

Mr. Craig said he has contracted with IT Corp to complete sampling and well development. He said they (IT) will be out on Friday to develop and Monday to sample.

Mr. Craig also said the requested deposit was remitted on 4-1-91, yet no funds have been data inputted in the office.

Six samples of the stock pile were analyzed and results are known. I requested a copy of these results.

Steve Lagueine of RWQCB called me today regarding his conversation yesterday (4-23) with Jim Craig, manager of the above facility.

We discussed a compromise for the initial phases of H2O investigations, as follows:

- 1) install one(1) groundwater monitoring well in the "best guess" downgradient position, within 10' of the former UST pit. Soil samples are to be continually logged, ~~at~~ samples collected every 5' B.G., ~~at~~ where contamination is noted, and changes in lithology.
- 2) Initial soil samples are to be tested using EPA Test Method 8240, and for soluble lead. Water samples will be analyzed using 601 (C1 HC), and for organic lead.
- 3) Further wells may be required following receipt of groundwater info ~~as~~ subsequent to the installation of wells at the Shell Station at the corner of LK. Chabot and C.V. Blvd.
- 4) Well Survey w/in 1/2 mile radius

I spoke with Mr. C. Norman Gadsby, attorney to the property owner, regarding the request for site assessment. Mr. Gadsby was returning my call of Feb. 28.

Mr. Gadsby was under the impression that, because TPH concentrations were either very low (<100 ppm) or N.D., no groundwater investigation was warranted. I advised him that non-fuel contaminants were present in soil samples, including methylene chloride and trichloroethylene. The mere presence of these compounds in soil in proximity to the USTs dictates the need for further assessment.

I requested that he contact Lester Feldman of the RWQCB. If the RWQCB says no further work is required or is willing to confirm that a compromise work plan will be acceptable, then that will be fine with this office. I spoke with Mr. Feldman about this subject and told him to expect a call from Mr. Gadsby.
