


Recently, you should have received a report from Gettler-Ryan, Inc. containing GeoProbe® collected from this site on May 14, 1999 at your request. The purpose was to verify the presence of MtBE found in MW-7 (adjacent to the tank pit) during the last monitoring and sampling event. It is my understanding that all the monitoring wells were destroyed prior to your receipt of the final sampling data. Based upon new information from the last sampling event and the results of the GeoProbe® investigation, I understand that you will be re-opening the case and require delineation of the MtBE. From our telephone conversation, I am under the impression that Tosco will be named as the Primary Responsible Party.

I reviewed historical monitoring and sampling data and find there have been high levels of dissolved hydrocarbons and MtBE (up to 10,000 ppb) in at least one well, also adjacent to the tank pit, prior to the change of ownership in 1994. Please refer to the figure below. Levels of dissolved petroleum hydrocarbons and in particular, the ratios between dissolved constituents, have remained at similar levels since that time. You will also note that the screened interval for well MW-4 (and other wells for that matter) has been submerged since the initial sampling in 1992. I am under the impression that no active remediation has ever occurred at this site. For that reason, I do not believe that Tosco should be the primary responsible party for the additional MtBE investigation.
