Hi Mark,

For site RO2438 (Chevron 9-2029, 890 West MacArthur, Oakland), we submitted a *Work Plan for Additional Investigation* on August 25, 2009 that proposed the drilling of two additional borings to further evaluate the down-gradient extent of impacted groundwater. As you know, we have not yet received a response from ACEH regarding the work plan. However, after looking further at the results of the previous borings, we would like to slightly alter the proposed boring locations to those shown on the attached figure. We feel the updated locations would give us better definition. We are aware that you likely won't be able to review the case file for a while, but wanted to get this in your hands prior to that point. As with the several other sites we already discussed, we may proceed without ACEH concurrence if too much time passes. Any questions let me know. Thanks.
