Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has received the most recently submitted report entitled, "First Quarter 2008 Groundwater Monitoring Report and Request for No Further Action Status, New West Stations Livermore — Bernard's Gas, 1051 Airway Boulevard, Livermore, California," dated March 27, 2008 and prepared on your behalf by Closure Solutions, Inc. The report presents the results from groundwater sampling activities conducted on February 19, 2008 and recommends that the case be granted No Further Action Status. The case is currently under consideration for case closure by ACEH. During the review for possible case closure, quarterly groundwater monitoring may be suspended. Following completion of ACEH review and California Regional Water Quality Control Board concurrence, the case will be closed or ACEH will provide further directives for investigation or cleanup.
