Dear Mr. Seeto:

I have completed review of Sigma Prime Geosciences, Inc's April 2001 *Soil Analytical Study Site Closure Report* prepared for the above referenced site. Soil that was previously contaminated by waste oil (due to bad storage and management practices of waste oil) was excavated and recycled by Filter Recycling Services, in Bloomington, CA. Confirmation soil samples were collected from the pit bottom after excavation. Soil samples were analyzed for total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg), TPH as diesel, TPH as motor oil, total oil and grease, benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes (BTEX), and total lead. Analytical results were unremarkable.

Based upon the available information and with the provision that the information provided to this agency was accurate and representative of site conditions, no further action related to the surface contamination by waste oil is required. Please be aware that further work may be required if conditions change or a water quality threat is discovered at this specific site.
