



Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the Spills, Leaks, Investigations, and Cleanups (SLIC) case file for the above referenced site. The most recent report in the ACEH file is a Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring Report dated September 17, 1998 that was prepared by AEI Environmental, Inc. The Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring Report dated September 17, 1998 presents analytical results from four groundwater sampling events conducted between July 31, 1997 and June 15, 1998. Two wells (AE-1 and MW-2) are located southeast (apparent downgradient direction) of the former dry cleaning facility at 1353 During the groundwater sampling event on March 3, 1998, International Boulevard. tetrachloroethene (PCE) and trichloroethene (TCE) were not detected in the groundwater sample collected from well AE-1 and were detected in the sample from well MW-2 at concentrations of 3.7 and 14 micrograms per liter (µg/L), respectively. The report recommended no further groundwater monitoring and closure of the site based on these results. Although PCE and TCE were not detected at significantly elevated concentrations in groundwater samples from wells AE-1 and MW-2, PCE was detected at a concentration of 1,100 μg/L in a grab groundwater sample collected from BH-1, which is also southeast of the former dry cleaning facility. Boring BH-1 extended to a depth of 8 feet bgs and wells AE-1 and MW-2 extend to depths of 15 and 15.5 feet bgs, respectively. These results indicate that the most contaminated groundwater beneath the site is likely within 10 feet of ground surface. For the evaluation of potential indoor vapor intrusion, the concentrations of volatile compounds in the upper portion of the water column are more significant than the concentrations in the lower portion of the water column. The concentration of PCE detected in the grab groundwater sample from BH-1 exceeds San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board Environmental Screening Levels for potential indoor vapor intrusion from contaminated groundwater.

All soil and groundwater sampling to date has been conducted outside the building. In order to evaluate the potential for indoor vapor intrusion, we request that you conduct soil vapor of subfloor sampling within the former dry cleaning facility at 1353 International Boulevard in the areas of the former dry cleaning machine, floor drains, and sanitary sewer lines. I am in receipt of the phase II subsurface investigation report, dated January 31, 1997 prepared by All Environmental, Inc. For the above referenced property. This letter includes some modifications to the letter dated March 25, 1997 and replaces the latter. Based on a review done by this Department, the following additional work is needed to reasonably define the extent of contamination at the referenced site.

- Since significant concentrations of PCE, ranging from 22 ppb to 1100 ppb was identified in the groundwater samples collected from the referenced property, a monitoring well should be installed near and down gradient to boring location BH-1. The installed well should be monitored at a quarterly frequency for a minimum of one year.
- The groundwater gradient in the referenced site should be determined by including the wells located at the General Tires Property. Also, the wells located on the adjacent site should be monitored at least semi-annually to get information on the fate and transport of the PCE.
- Since usually solvents can be transported along the sewer system or other conduits, soil samples should be collected along this path to determine the extent of transport. Hence this Department requires that the path of the sewer lines, starting from the dry cleaning area, be traced, based on which a determination will be made as to the adequacy of the previous soil sampling locations and the need if any for additional soil samples.

The work plan should be implemented within 30 days from the date of this letter. This is a formal request pursuant to Section 2720 et seq, Article 11, Title 23, California Code of Regulations, and Section 25185.6 of the Health and Safety Code. Also, prior to initiating any field work, this Department should be notified.

Dear Mr. Foss, The Trust Administrator, Mr. Stepney & Ms. Stepney:

This letter is being sent to inform you of the solvent contamination identified in the groundwater at a site located at Former General Tires at 1201 14th Avenue, Oakland, CA, which is adjacent and downgradient to the referenced property. Based on the data/information submitted to this Department and site history, the referenced property is being considered as one of the potential sources of this contamination.

Three monitoring wells have been installed at the Former General Tire and perchloroethylene and other solvents have been consistently identified in the upgradient monitoring well, MW-2 which is located less than 20 feet from the referenced site. Also, the referenced property is being used as a dry cleaner which usually involves the use of perchloroethylene for normal operation of the drycleaning equipment:

Please submit a workplan to this Department within 45 days to investigate the site as a potential source of solvent contamination in the soil and groundwater. This is a formal request for technical information and any delays to the submittal should be requested in writing

Also, please remit \$1200.00 to establish a deposit-refund account. This deposit is authorized by Alameda County ordinance code section 3-141.6 to cover expenses incurred by county personnel for their oversight duties. Records are maintained for the time County employees commit to a project and the deposit will be debited at the rate of \$94.00 per hour for any time dedicated to your project. Any money remaining in your account at the end of the project will be refunded. Additional monies may be needed if the project exhausts the fund. Please submit a check payable to "Treasurer, County of Alameda" with the words "Site Mitigation" written on the check for proper credit. Also, please make sure to include the complete address of the site for which the deposit- refund account is being established.
