Subject: Proposed Wipe Sampling Plan for Protron Technology Brandin Court, Fremont, California

Dear Madhulla,

Could you please review this as soon as possible, so that I can schedule Sukid for the sampling as soon as possible. Please let me know if you would like any changes. Thank you very much.

Attached are two maps, one shows the results of the November 13, 1998 wipe sampling that Sukla De and I conducted, and the other is the proposed Wipe Sampling Locations for confirmation that an adequate cleanup has been provided at Brandin Court. As you will note, the November 13 sampling event showed that some additional cleanup was warranted in the location of sample SW8 (the test room), in the location of SW22 (for the surface areas above the conference room), and of the floor in the location of SW20 and SW21, if the cleanup was to meet the current HUD standard.

On inspection, it was determined that the top of all of the ductwork above the offices and exposed light fixtures in the drop ceiling, and other exposed surfaces needed additional cleaning. I determined that the fiberglass insulation covering the drop ceiling could not be cleaned and would need to be removed, and all of the hard, non-permeable surfaces (i.e. the tops of the light fixtures, the exhaust ductwork, and accessible conduit and plumbing, would need wiping down. This was done, and all of these structures above the drop ceiling over office areas were cleaned (except for the inaccessible fire sprinkler plumbing at the roof, as per our discussion) and this area is now ready for retesting.

I propose that we collect the following samples:

- Two wall samples from inside of the office areas in 5045 Brandin Court. 1.

Two ductwork samples from above the office areas in 5045 Brandin Court.

Two ceiling light samples from above the office areas in 5045 Brandin Court.

Two blank samples for control.

Two floor samples from vicinity of SW20 and SW21 in 5035 Brandin Court.

Ceiling & Room arch.

Larp (Ceiling - Room eschaust WSIf WS9)

Air conduction - outside ->

Kire Sprenkles line (near soldie)

The sample locations will be selected and collected in the presence of Ms. Sukla De of the Fremont Fire Departments, utilizing the Appendix 13.1 Wipe Sampling Protocol for Settled Lead-contaminated Dust that she provided. Samples will be collected approximately 20 - 30 feet distances from each other so as to provide an adequate coverage of the areas of concern.

As I mentioned, in addition to wipe cleaning, we removed the fiberglass insulation since it cannot be cleaned. The insulation has been bagged and will be disposed of as hazardous waste by placing in a hazardous waste disposal bin and shipping to a permitted hazardous waste facility. The disposal will take place after all of the cleanup has been completed, and the sampling results confirmating.
