Dear Mr. Chan:

As we discussed during our phone conversation yesterday, the Port of Oakland (Port) recently submitted the subject underground storage tank (UST) investigation workplans for sites located within the 9th Avenue Terminal Area in Oakland, CA. Initially, we requested your review and approval of these workplans prior to implementation, although circumstances have changed as discussed below.

The Ninth Avenue Terminal Complex, including all the subject UST sites, is contained within a larger proposed development area known as the Oak to Ninth District (District). The entire District is slated for redevelopment. Further UST site investigations will be deferred until the overall redevelopment of the District. All underground storage tank (UST) work will be incorporated into site remediation and management. The schedule for this work, however, is uncertain because it is based on the time required for the Port to close escrow with the developer, Oakland Harbor Partners.

The following workplans and UST sites are affected by this change in approach:

- Final Site Investigation Workplan, UST HF-19 at Building H-314 Ninth Avenue Terminal, Oakland, CA, submitted May 2, 2003

- Final Site Investigation Workplan, USTs HF-20 and HF-21 at Building H-317 Ninth Avenue Terminal, Oakland, CA (LOP 5067), submitted May 2, 2003
- Fuel Leak Case RO0000109, 845 Embarcadero, Suspected Site of USTs HF-12 and HF-13, Oakland, CA (LOP 225), submitted December 9, 2002
