I have completed review of  $H_2OGEOL$ 's September 1995 Soil Sampling, Monitoring Well Installation report for the above referenced site. The report documents the installation of three groundwater monitoring wells and the initial groundwater sampling event.

Groundwater does not appear to be significantly impacted by the fuel release at the site. To verify this, quarterly monitoring of the wells should be established for the site. After four consecutive quarters of sampling, the site will be evaluated for possible case closure. The next sampling event should have been in September 1995. If this has not occurred, you should initiate sampling as soon as possible. Quarterly monitoring reports (QMRs) are due within 60 days upon completion of field work.
