Dear Ms. Roe:

On behalf of ExxonMobil Oil Corporation, thank you for the letter dated 6 September 2013 commenting on the May 2013 Work Plan for Subsurface Investigation and following up on the 5 September 2013 conference call regarding the above-referenced site. As requested, please see the attached site map with updated proposed boring locations. As discussed, the location of proposed CPT boring H1 will be moved closer to the area of boring B18 and well RW1, and new CPT boring H3 is proposed in the western corner of the site. In addition, a minimum of one soil sample will be collected from a boring at H1 and analyzed for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons as gasoline, benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, xylenes, methyl tertiary butyl ether, tertiary butyl ether, and naphthalene to further assess the vertical extent of gasoline constituent impacts in soil. Also, as part of the Low-Threat UST Case Closure Policy, soil samples will be collected from soil vapor borings V2 and V3 (near the former pump islands) at depths of approximately 3 and 6.5 feet below grade for naphthalene analysis. Soil samples will be collected from soil vapor boring V6 (near the former used oil tank excavation) at depths of approximately 3 and 6.5 feet below grade for polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbon (PAH) analysis.

Drilling is scheduled to begin on 4 November 2013. Therefore, we request an extension of the Soil and Water Investigation and Focused SCM Report due date from 6 December 2013 to 30 December 2013.


