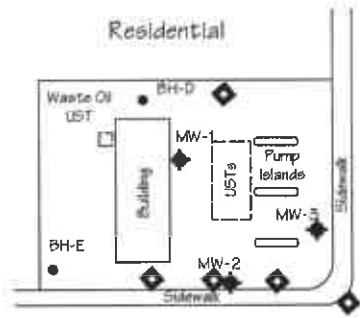

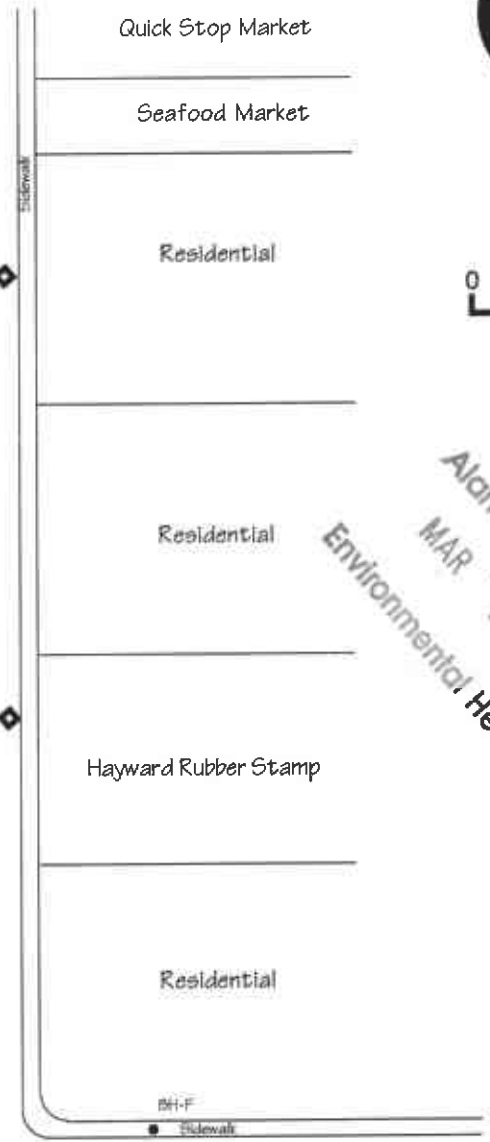

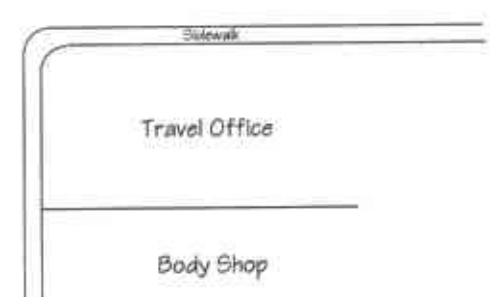
FLAGG AVENUE
