Our case file review indicates your property is up gradient of the subject site and groundwater impacts are localized to the area surrounding the former tank location. It is ACEHs opinion that it is unlikely the release at the site has impacted the 2222 Grant St. property

The property located at 2222 Grant St. was identified as having an industrial well. Information in the case file indicates the well is 320 feet deep. Are you aware of a well on your property? If so, what is its status- industrial use, active or inactive, location on the property. We would like to review any data you have on this well prior to proceeding with case closure. ACEH would like to include your comments for the closure package.
