Hello John,

I apologize for the delay in responding to your question to whether ACEH requires use of Oakland's RBCA guidance. The answer to your question no, you are not required to use Oakland's RBCA guidance to prepare a RBCA. However, we do recommend using chemical-specific cancer slope factors (both inhalation and oral) to follow CalEPA, not USEPA, recommended slope factors. Chemical-specific chronic reference doses (both inhalation and oral) should also follow CalEPA, not USEPA, recommended chronic reference doses).
