The following comments are in response to an ACEHS letter dated October 27, 2004 which reviewed Gettler-Ryan Inc.'s (GR) Preferential Pathway Study and Work Plan dated May 11, 2004 on behalf of Marie Schweickert.

Comments:

Source Area – GR will complete two additional soil borings within 10 to 15 feet of the source area as shown on the revised site map. Soil samples will be collected at 5-foot intervals from ground surface to 70 feet in depth. In addition, a third soil boring will be completed at the same location as former soil boring B-1 and soil samples collected at 5-foot intervals from 45 to 70 feet below ground surface. A grab groundwater sample will also be collected from each of the locations and a piezometer will be constructed at the B-1 location as outlined in the work plan as shown on the site map.

Lateral Definition – Soil borings/piezometers will be completed and installed after review of laboratory analytical data from the previously mentioned three source area soil borings. This will insure the borings will be of sufficient depth to vertically define the extent of contamination, as well as submitting the sufficient number of soil samples to define the lateral extent. This approach will result in two phases of field equipment mobilization to the site. Soil borings and piezometer locations have been adjusted as recommended by ACEHS with the exception of the proposed upgradient soil boring/piezometer location which is necessary control point for assessing groundwater conditions and flow direction at the site.


