Dear Mr. Ippolito:

This letter confirms the completion of site investigation and remedial action for the soil contamination that was due to used oil being dumped at the above referenced site and onto the adjacent US Postal Service Property vacant lot. A total of 12 drums of contaminated soil was excavated at the Postal Service lot and disposed at Kettleman Cit CA. Confirmation soil samples contained up to 4,500 ppm total oil and grease. It appea that overexcavation was effective in removing most of the hydrocarbon-impacted soil.

Based upon the available information and with the provision that the information provider to this agency was accurate and representative of site conditions, no further action relative to the surface contamination by used oil is required.
