Re: No Further Action at Fallon and Croak Roads, Pleasanton, CA

Dear Mr. Inderbitzen:

This letter confirms the completion of site investigation and remedial action for the soil contaminated with diesel fuel at the above referenced address. In December 1998 a dump truck with trailer traveled off the road onto the parcel located northwest of the intersection of Fallon Road and Croak Road. The accident resulted in the release of diesel fuel to the surficial soil. Approximately 28 tons of diesel-impact soil was excavated and subsequently disposed at Altamont Landfill, in Livermore, California. Confirmation soil samples collected from the excavation at three to four feet below ground surface did not contain diesel fuel constituents.

Based upon the available information and with the provision that the information provided to this agency was accurate and representative of site conditions, no further action related to the surface contamination by diesel fuel is required.
