Dear Ms. Logan:

Per your request, this letters serves as an Addendum to the work plan dated February 11, 1994. Per our conversation on February 16, 1994, you requested additional information regarding the collection of samples from the proposed borings.

The two proposed borings will be installed beyond the known extent of soil contamination to:

- 1) define extent of lead and copper contamination within the groundwater,
- 2) to acquire background data on fill material similar to the on-site fill, and
- 3) to establish background levels of lead and copper in the soil and groundwater.

Soil samples will be collected from each boring every two to three feet starting at two feet below grade to approximately 15 feet below grade. It is anticipated that groundwater will occur approximately seven to ten feet below ground surface. Soil samples from each boring collected above the saturated zone will be submitted for analysis.

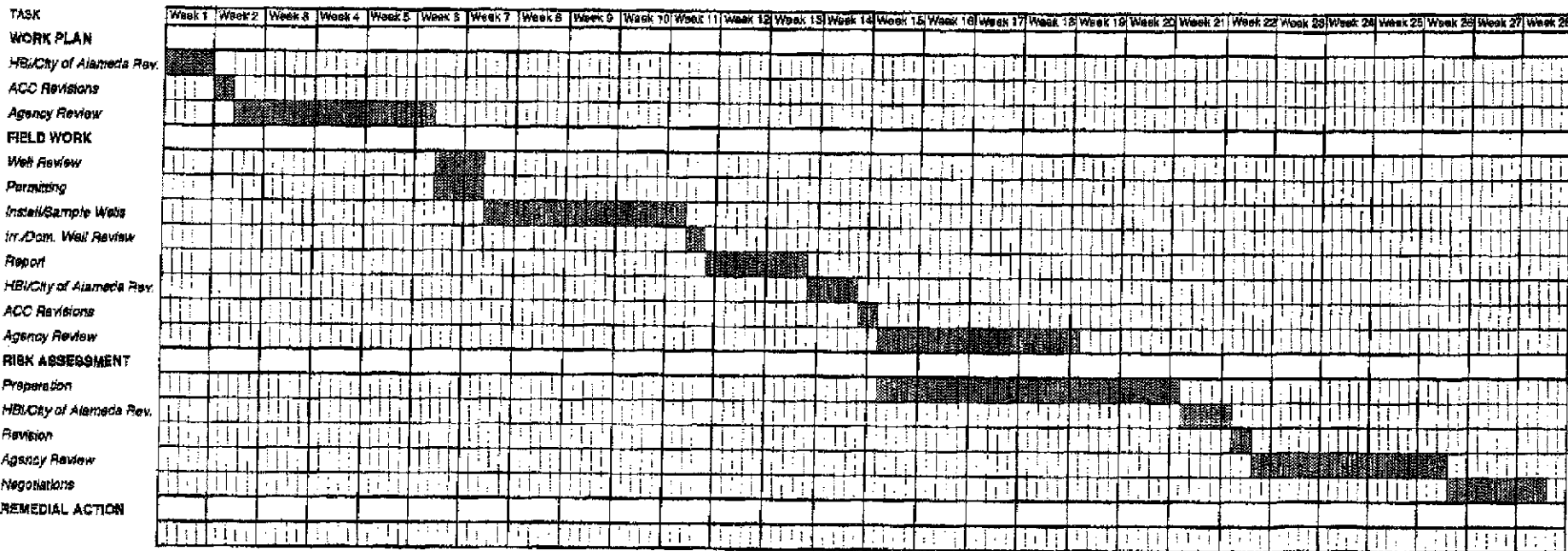
