INTRODUCTION

At your request we have performed an environmental assessment of the subject property. The purpose of the study is to evaluate the presence of hazardous materials at the site, and the potential impacts on the site from possible off-site sources. The site is located on the north side of Railroad Avenue between North "L" and North "N" streets and is bordered by the Western Pacific Railroad on the north, as shown on Figure 1. The site is presently occupied by small businesses, residences, and vacant land. We understand that the site is intended by the City of Livermore for redevelopment.

SCOPE OF WORK

To assess whether there is evidence of possible environmental contamination at the site from hazardous materials or waste, available data was reviewed, a site reconnaissance was performed, and the results were analyzed and are summarized in this report. The evaluation of data included a review of site history from aerial photographs, and an interview with a long time city employee. Available information about spills or releases of hazardous material was obtained from the Livermore City Fire Department, The Alameda County Environmental Health Division, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQC8) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (Appendix A).

A reconnaissance of the site was performed on December 7, 1988 by Albert Ridley, a senior project geologist, and Ann McDonald, a senior staff scientist for Woodward-Clyde Consultants. The purpose of the reconnaissance was to observe the surface of the site and inspect the interior of the buildings for evidence of spills or present and past use or storage of hazardous materials. This work is summarized in this report along with supporting documents.

SITE HISTORY

Aerial photographs of the site taken in 1957, 1971 and 1984 were reviewed. The photographs taken on 5/16/57 show the site as entirely residential on the west half of the area, locally referred to as Tubbsville, located east of North "N" Street. There were 36 structures on place, there were residences at 1962 Railroad Avenue was in Street, and a gas station at 187 North "L" Street. The photographs taken on 5/7/84 show the gas station pump island had been removed. There is no apparent activity by the railroad on the south complex, Tubbsville, had been removed.

The state listings consulted for this review included: (1) North Bay Toxic Cases List (RWQCB, September 1988); Fuel Leaks List (RWQCB, October 1988); and (3) Expenditure Plan for the Hazardous Substance Cleanup Bond Act of 1984, January 1988, Revision No. 3 (Department of Health Services, Toxic Substance Control Division).

There are no reported cases within approximately a 2,000 foot radius of the subject property on the North Bay Toxics Cases List (Appendix A). As shown on Figure 1, there are two reported fuel leaks in the site vicinity (Appendix A). The fuel leaks reported are listed below.

- Mobil 2008 First Street Livermore
- Pacific Bell 2324 Second Street Livermore

There are no reported cases within approximately a 2,000 foot radius of the subject property listed on the Expenditure Plan for Hazardous Substance Cleanup Bond Act of 1984.

# REPORTED SPILLS AND RELEASES

Federal and State regulatory lists related to fuel leak and toxic waste sites were consulted to identify known fuel leaks and toxic waste sites near the project site. The federal listings consulted were the National Priorities List (NPL), Final and Proposed Sites, July 1987, and the Federal in the vicinity of the site within a one half mile radius.

A letter was sent to the Environmental Protection Agency, Office of External Affairs to obtain Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Information System (CERCLIS) and Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 (RCRA) updated copies of pertinent records regarding surrounding properties to evaluate whether hazardous waste or toxic substance activities in the area may impact the site. The results and interpretation of the CERCLIS and RCRA updated records will be forwarded to you when they are received from EPA. Meanwhile, the currently available data bases were reviewed and are reported as follows.

The CERCLIS data base contains potential uncontrolled hazardous waste sites. The CERCLIS system contains only those potential hazardous waste sites that have been brought to the attention of EPA. The EPA CERCLIS data base for June 8, 1988 contains the following site location listing (Appendix A and Figure 1).

The facilities listed in the EPA HWDMS data base are regulated under the Resources Conservation and Recovery Act. The HWDMS system contains only those regulated facilities that have notified the EPA of their status as hazardous waste generators, transporters, or treatment, storage or disposal facilities. ## GROUNDWATER CONDITIONS

A report prepared by the California Department of Water Resources (1974) shows the site is located in the Mocho Groundwater Subbasin. A near-surface unconfined groundwater zone is reported to occur within 25 feet of the ground surface. The near-surface water level surface is reported as sloping generally northward or northwestward. A deeper confined groundwater zone has a potentiometric surface 75 to 150 feet below the ground.

Whether the groundwater conditions reported in 1974 are present today is uncertain. A considerable amount of groundwater usage since 1974 may have affected the present groundwater conditions.

## SITE RECONNAISSANCE

The site surface and buildings were observed during the site visit, and whenever possible, occupants of the building were interviewed (see Figure 2). The buildings are generally concrete and wood non-insulated

Arrow Rentals is located at 187 North "L" Street. The owner of the property, Tony Sullins, was interviewed. He bought the property in 1972. There were five underground storage tanks in place at that time, one 6,000 gallon, one 4,000 gallon, and three 1,500 gallon tanks. The three 1,500 gallon tanks were removed in 1972 because they were tested and found to be leaking in either the connecting pipes or the tanks. The 6,000 and 4,000 gallon tanks were removed in 1984. They had been in place more than 40 years. There is one 1,000 gallon tank in place and being used now (Figure 2). It is located in the southeast corner of the property, near the street. According to Mr. Sullins, it is a single wall tank. According to Deputy Fire Marshall Eric Carlson, the permit was issued for it in 1984.

This small business rents a variety of construction equipment which is stored and maintained on the premises. Five barrels of diesel and two barrels of waşte oil are kept on the premises. The back storage area was paved three or four years ago. There are two catch basins located about 50 feet from the street on the south side of the building. They are used for washing equipment and they drain into the storm sewer.

Fabtronics is located at 1940 Railroad Avenue. Richard Arney, the owner of Fabtronics, was interviewed. This business builds specialized electronic equipment to specification in small quantities. It has been in this location for 18 years. Solvents such as laquer thinner are used to clean silk screens. Approximately 10 gallons per year are used. There are approximately fifty 1-gallon partially used paint cans, approximately thinner, several empty laquer thinner cans, three 5-gallon cans of laquer cutting metal and a 55 gallon drum of kerosene for the heater. There is a vented paint room in the north east corner of the building.

Being Control of the Control of the

Eric Carlson, Deputy Fire Marshal, City of Livermore Fire Prevention was contacted to obtain records and information concerning underground storage tanks (USTs) in the site vicinity. According to Deputy Carlson the Fire Department has purged all records older than seven years. He has been with the Department for eight years. Ms. Ann McDonald of WCC, was given the following information in a telephone interview with Deputy Carlson on 12/6/88. The Fire Department never kept records until 11 or 12 years ago, and did not keep a fee schedule until one year ago. Therefore, the Department records are very limited and incomplete. There are a number of USTs within a one half mile radius of the subject property. The following locations were sited by Deputy Carlson:

- Lucky's Depot Plaza 2073 Railroad Ave. may have had a gas station and tanks
- Mobil Station
   NE corner of First & S. "L" Streets
- Arrow Rentals 187 N. "L" Street formally 175 N. "L"

A letter has been sent to the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health, Division of Hazardous Materials requesting information concerning hazardous waste or toxic substance activities on the subject property or within the immediate vicinity of the property. The results and interpretation of information will be forwarded to you when they are received from the Department of Environmental Health.

Mr. Lowell Miller, Hazardous Materials Specialist, of the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health was contacted concerning a remedial activity taking place on the south side of Railroad Ave. between South "L" and South "P" Streets. This area was referred to by Mr. Miller as the Super Block Project. According to Mr. Miller the problem concerned an underground storage bunker vault area associated with the railroad. He viewed the material at the bottom of the concrete vault and described it as "a tar like material which was not very mobile." The material is number six grade fuel oil seeping from the vault and pipeline. Soil contamination is confined to the surface soil. Contamination levels have been found in concentrations of 530 ppm, stock piled material has been tested at 1000 ppm total petroleum hydrocarbons, and oil and grease at 13,000 ppm at 8 to 14 inch depths, and 2,100 ppm at four foot depths. The contaminated soil will be removed from the premises as soon as a disposal site is located. Mr. Miller says there is no concern about groundwater contamination, however the contractor has been requested to install a monitoring well as soon as practical in light of the present construction taking place. If the well is not installed they will be cited by the County as being in violation of regulations. Depth to groundwater has not been adequately explored and measured in the vicinity of the site.

Rooney Graphics is located at 1954 Railroad Ave. Joel Streufert, owner of Rooney Graphics, was interviewed. This is a small printing business. All processes are self-contained according to Mr. Streufert. The following chemicals were found on the premises:

- one 5-gallon can of "Quick Wash", a solvent for cleaning presses
- one 1-gallon can of stablizer
- one 1-gallon can of developer
- inks and color cans.

A vacant residence is located at 1962 Railroad Ave. A neighbor, Mrs. Denise Minoggio, claims there was once a domestic well on this property. A well house is located behind the residence on the north west corner of the property. There is no record of a well on the property according to Craig Mayfield, Alameda County Flood Control-Zone 7, however, there were no records maintained with this agency prior to 1963.

Residence is located at 141 "L" Street. According to Mrs. Denise Minoggio, the owner and occupant, the house had new heat and electrical systems installed in 1982.

A Taxidermy Shop is located at 153 "L" Street. Joe Troutman, the owner of the shop, was interviewed. The materials used on the premises are salt, water and alum. The salt water is disposed of occasionally at Mr. Troutman's ranch.

The storage lot south of and to the west of Arrow Rentals is presently used for storage by a landscaper, an electrical contractor and the owner, John Regan, who has a tree farm, according to Ms. Karen Majors.

Miscellaneous machinery, building materials, lumber, bark, old cars, 2 containerized storage units and a 30 foot trailer are stored on the property. There are four storage buildings, wooden structures apparently filled with building materials, debris, and about eight 1-gallon paint cans. There are empty cans, 1- and 5-gallon size empty cans of oil, paints, and gas scattered through out the property. There were two decomposing ceiling tiles, possibly asbestos, on the south side of the last building to the west. The material in question was saturated with water.

Tubbsville, a residential area, is located between the commercial buildings and North "N" Street.

This area is largely vacant land now with three dilapidated residences on the premises. Only one appears to be occupied, the other two were filled and surrounded with debris and abandoned cars.

#### SUMMARY

A review of aerial photographs showed that the residential area, Tubbsville, had approximately 36 structures until 1984, when a number of houses were demolished. At present there are only three residences

The Ross McDonald Company is located at 1938 Railroad Avenue. Barbara McDonald, one of the owners of the company was interviewed. The company has been at this location for 15 years. The company occupied the north half of the building only until 1984 when it expanded into the south half also. The south half was formally occupied by a T-shirt silk screening business before 1984. The Ross McDonald Company assembles and sells shelving systems and component parts. The following chemicals are stored on the premises:

- one 55-gallon drum of laquer paint thinner
- three 55-gallon drums of waterbased contact adhesive
- approximately seventy 1-gallon cans of laquer
- one 1-gallon can of karosene
- approximately thirty 1-pint cans of paint
- approximately 65 used cans of spray paint

Quality Painting Company is located at 1934 Railroad Avenue. It was not possible to inspect this facility because the owner was not present as previously arranged. There were approximately fifty 5-gallon containers and fifteen 1-gallon containers of acrylic paints observed to be stored in the north half of the building. There was also evidence of an underground storage tank at the north east corner of the building (Figure 2) where a gas pump and tank vent pipe were located. There is no information available on this tank from local, regional or state sources.

Accelerated Printing is located at 1908 Railroad Avenue. Donald Petrilli, owner of Accelerated Printing was interviewed, and the work area of the building toured. The following items were stored on the premises:

- solvents used in printing processes
- one 5-gallon can of "Blanket Wash"
- nine empty 5-gallon solvent cans
- tank for washing equipment, contents unknown.

Scheeringa Bros. Meat Processing is located at 1900 Railroad Ave. Alice Scheeringa, one of the owners of Scheeringa Bros. was interviewed. She said there are no hazardous materials used in meat processing, nor stored on the premises.

Award Signs was located at 1920 Railroad Ave. This building was vacated by Award Signs in October 1988. There was no access to this

Gibbons Electric is located at 1948 Railroad Ave. This building was occupied by Gibbons Electric from the early 1970's until fall 1988. The storage area behind the building has a concrete slab-on-grade. The storage area and building were filled with debris and approximately thirty empty 1gallon paint thinner and paint cans.

now in use at Arrow Rentals. We recommend one soil boring be drilled at the location of the underground storage tank at 1934 Railroad Avenue. The purpose of these borings is to explore for evidence of soil contamination. Laboratory analyses should be performed on soil samples from the borings to evaluate possible contamination from petroleum products or solvents, which might have been stored in the tanks. The exploratory borings should be about 20 to 25 feet deep and samples should be collected from near the surface and at 5 foot intervals using a drive sampler. If groundwater is encountered, several of the borings could be converted to groundwater monitoring wells.

A pile of ceiling tile was observed during the site reconnaissance in the storage area south of the Arrow Rentals property. We recommend that one sample of ceiling tile be collected and tested for asbestos in the laboratory.

We recommend that if domestic wells are found on the site prior to, or during site demolition, that the wells be properly sealed in accordance with state and local regulations. The purpose of sealing the wells is to reduce the potential for vertical migration of potential contaminants downward to the groundwater.

### Off-Site Source

There is a low potential for contaminants from the fuel leaks located 500 feet south of the site migrating to the site, considering the distance. Contaminants from the former PG&E gas plant also have a low potential for affecting the site since the PG&E site is probably "downgradient from the site. Based upon information from the Alameda County DEH, there is a low potential for migration of contaminants from the Super Block site to the subject site.

We understand that a monitoring well is scheduled to be installed south of the site on the Super Block project. We recommend that the City of Livermore obtain groundwater reports from that well in order to further evaluate the possibility of off site contamination moving toward the subject property from the Super Block site.

#### LIMITATIONS

The scope of this investigation is limited to visual observation of surface conditions at the site, and a review of readily available reports and literature. Sampling and laboratory analyses were beyond the scope of this environmental review.

The environmental review addressed the likelihood of hazardous substance contamination resulting from past and current known uses of the site and adjacent properties. As a result, certain conditions may not be revealed: 10 naturally occurring toxics in the subsurface soils, rocks, water, or the toxicity of the on-site flora; 2) toxicity of substances common in current habitable environments, such as, stored house hold

There is a 1,000 gallon unleaded underground gasoline storage tank, permitted in 1984, presently in use at 187 North "L" Street., There is a vent pipe and gas pump located at 1934 Railroad Ave. indicating the presence of an underground gasoline storage tank. However, no information was found from state, county or local records indicating the size, age or past history of the tank. Buildings and storage areas on the commercial section of the site have concrete slab-on-grade floors. The area south of the site between South "L" and South "P" Streets, known as Super Block, is in the process of remediation for soil contaminated by petroleum products. The contamination is confined to the near surface soils according to the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health. No groundwater contamination is anticipated by the County, and the contaminated soil is scheduled to be removed. Alameda County DEH has requested that a monitoring well be installed at the Super Block site as soon as construction activities permit.

There are two reported fuel leaks about 500 feet south of the site, which are probably upgradient from the subject property if groundwater flows northwestward. There is one potential hazardous waste site (PG&E gas plant) reported by CERCLIS about 200 feet downgradient from the site. There are seven sites within approximately 2,000 feet of the subject property listed on the RCRA data base, four of which are probably cross gradient. Three sites, two Pacific Bell sites, and a Shell Station are probably upgradient from the subject property.

# CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

### On-Site Sources

A review of the site history indicates that underground gasoline and petroleum product storage tanks at the "Arrow Rentals" location experienced, leakage prior to their removal in 1971. The two largest tanks removed had been in place more than 40 years, raising the possibility they may have developed leaks due to deterioration over time. The history of these tanks indicates there is a potential for soil being contaminated with petroleum, products. There is also evidence of an underground gasoline storage tank at 1934 Railroad Avenue. However, there are no available records or information about the age or contents of this tank.

We recommend that one soil boring be drilled at the location of each of the five storage tanks which have been removed. One boring should be; drilled downgradient and in the backfill material of the 1,000 gallon-tank-




Figure 1 - Fuel Leaks, RCRA and CERCLIS Cases

Figure 2 - Property Location Map



f 1177 final and proposed sites. EPA is roposing to include on the NPL sites at which there are or have been releases or hreatened releases of hazardous ubstances, or of "pollutants or ontaminants." The discussion below nay refer to "releases or threatened eleases" simply as "releases," facilities," or "sites."

#### I. Purpose of the NPL

The primary purpose of the NPL is stated in the legislative history of CERCLA (Report of the Committee on Environment and Public Works, Sensia Report No. 98–848, 96th Cong., 2d Sess. 80 (1980)]:

The priority lists serve primarily informational purposes, identifying for the States and the public those facilities and sites or other releases which appear to warrant remedial actions. Inclusion of a facility or site on the list does not in itself reflect a judgment of the activities of its owner or operator. It does not require those persons to undertake any action, nor does it assign liability to any person. Subsequent government action in the form of remedial actions or enforcement actions will be necessary in order to do so, and these actions will be attended by all appropriate procedural safeguards.

The primary purpose of the NPL therefore, is to serve as an informational tool for use by EPA in identifying sites that appear to warrant further investigation and possible remedial action under CERCLA, inclusion of a site on the NPL does not establish that EPA necessarily will undertake remedial actions. Moreover, listing does not require any action of any private party. nor does it determine the liability of any party for the cost of cleanup at the site. In addition, a site need not be on the NPL to be the subject of CERCLAfinanced removal actions, remedial investigations/feasibility studies, or actions brought pursuant to section 108 or 107(a)(4)(B) of CERCLA.

In addition, although the HRS scores used to place sites on the NPL may be helpful to the Agency in determining priorities for cleanup and other response activities. EPA does not rely on the scores as the sole means of determining such priorities. The information collected to develop HRS scores is not sufficient in itself to determine the appropriate remedy for a particular site. EPA relies on further, more detailed studies to determine what response, if any, is appropriate. These studies will take into account the extent and magnitude of the contaminants in the environment, the risk to affected populations, the cost to correct problems at the site, and the response actions that have been taken by potentially responsible parties or others. Decisions

on the type and extent of action to be taken at these sites are made in accordance with the criteria contained in Subpart F of the NCP. After conducting these additional studies. EPA may conclude that it is not desirable to conduct response action at some sites on the NPL because of more pressing needs at other sites, or because an enforcement action may instigate or force private-party cleanup. Given the limited resources available in the Hazardous Substances Superfund, the Agency must carefully balance the relative needs for response at the numerous sites it has studied. It is also possible that EPA will conclude after further analysis that the site does not warrant response action.

#### III. NPL Update Process

There are three mechanisms for placing sites on the NPL. The principal mechanism is the application of the HRS. The HRS serves as a screening device to evaluate the relative potential of uncontrolled hazardous substances to cause human health or safety problems, or ecological or environmental damage. The HRS takes into account "pathways" to human health or environmental exposure in terms of numerical scores. Those sites that score 28.50 or greater on the HRS, and which meet listing policies, are proposed.

The Superfund Amendments and Resuthorization Act ["SARA"], enacted on October 17, 1988, directs EPA to revise the HRS. The Agency will continue to use the existing HRS until the effective date for the revised HRS. Sites on the final NPL prior to the effective date of the revised HRS will not be reevaluated, as provided by CERCLA section 105(c)[3].

The second mechanism for adding sites to the NPL is by State designation. Each State may designate a single site as its top priority, regardless of the HRS score. This mechanism is provided by section 105(a)[8](B) of CERCLA, as amended, which requires that, to the extent practicable, the NPL include within the one hundred highest priorities at least one facility designated by each State as representing the greatest danger to public health, welfare, or the environment among known facilities in the State.

The third mechanism for listing, included in the NCP at 40 CFR 300.68(b)(4) (50 FR 37524. September 16, 1985), has been used only in rare instances; it allows certain sites with HRS scores below 28.50 to be eligible for the NPL. These sites may qualify for the NPL if all of the following occur:

 The Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry of the U.S.

Department of Health and Human Services has issued a health advisory which recommends dissociation of individuals from the release.

- EPA determines that the release poses a significant threat to public health.
- EPA anticipates that it will be more cost-effective to use its remedial authority than to use its removal authority to respond to the release.


States have the primary responsibility for identifying sites, computing HRS scores, and submitting candidate sites to the EPA Regional Offices. EPA Regional Offices conduct a quality control review of the States' candidate sites, and may assist in investigating, monitoring, and scoring sites. Regional Offices may consider candidate sites in addition to those submitted by States. EPA Headquarters conducts further quality assurance audits to ensure accuracy and consistency among the various EPA and State offices participating in the scoring. The Agency then proposes the new sites that meet the criteria for listing and solicits public comments on the proposal. Based on these comments and further EPA review, the Agency determines final scores and promulgates those sites that still qualify for listing.

An original NPL of 406 sites was promulgated on September 8, 1983 (48 FR 40658). The NPL has since been expanded (see 49 FR 19480, May 8, 1984; 49 FR 37070, September 21, 1984: 50 FR 8320. February 14, 1985; 50 FR 37630. September 18, 1985; 51 FR 21054, june 10. 1986, and 32 FR 27620. July 22, 1987). On March 7, 1986 (51 FR 7935), EPA deleted eight sites from the NPL and on April 18. 1988 (\$3 FR 12880) deleted three more sites. The number of final NPL sites is 799, including 32 Federal facility sites. Another 149 sites (including 16 Federal facility sites) from previous updates remain proposed for the NPL (see 48 FR 40674, September 8, 1983; 49 FR 40320. October 15, 1984; 50 FR 14113, April 10. 1985; 50 FR 37950. September 18, 1985; 51 FR 21099. June 10, 1988, and 52 FR 2492. January 22, 1987). With the 229 sites in proposed Update #7, 378 sites are not proposed for the NPL Final and proposed sites total 1177.

## IV. Public Comment Pariod

This Federal Register notice, which proposes sites for NPL Update #7, opens the formal 50-day comment-period.

The "ADDRESSESS" portion of this notice contains information on where to obtain documents relating to the scoring of these proposed sites. Documents providing EPA's justification for proposing these sites are available to the public in both the Headquarters public docket and in the appropriate Regional Office public docket.

The Headquarters public docket for NPL Update #7 contains: HRS score sheets for each proposed site: a Documentation Record for each site describing the technical rationale for the HRS scores: pertinent information for any site affected by special study waste or Resource Conservation and Recovery Act [RCRA] or other listing policies; and a list of documents referenced in the Documentation Record. The Headquarters public docket is located in EPA Headquarters, Waterside Mall Subbasement, 401 M Street SW., Washington, DC 20450, and is available for viewing by appointment only from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday excluding Federal holidays. Requests for copies of the HRS documents may be directed to the EPA Hasdquarters docket office.

The Regional public dockets contain all information available in the Headquarters docket, including HPS score sheets. Documentation Records. pertinent RCRA or special study waste information, and a list of reference documents for each site in that Region. These Regional dockets also include the reference documents themselves, which contain the data EPA relied upon in calculating or evaluating the HRS secres. The reference documents are available only in the Regional public dockets. These reference documents may be viewed by appointment only in the appropriate Regional Office, and requests for copies may be directed to the appropriate Regional docket or Superfund Branch, Documents relevant to the scoring of each site, but which were not used as formal references, are also a available in the appropriate Regional Office, and, in some cases, State or EPA contractor offices. These may be viewed and copied by arrangement with the appropriate office. In all cases, an informal written request. rather than a formal request, should be the ordinary procedure. for obtaining copies of any document.

EPA considers all comments received during this formal comment period. Comments are placed into the Headquarters docket and, during the comment period, are available to the public only in the Headquarters docket. A complete set of comments periaining to sites in a particular EPA Region will

be available for viewing in the Regional Office docket approximately one week following the close of the formal comment period. Comments received after the close of the comment period will be available in the Headquarters docket and in the appropriate Regional Office docket on an "as received" basis. An informal written request, rather than a formal request, should be the ordinary procedure for obtaining copies of these comments. After considering the relevant comments received during the comment period, EPA will add to the NPL all proposed sites that meet EPA's criteria for listing. In past NPL rulemakings, EPA has considered, to the extent practicable, comments received after the close of the comment period. EPA will attempt to do so in this rulemaking as well. However, because of the large number of sites proposed. and the need to respond to comments and finalize sites prior to the effective date of the revised HRS, EPA may no longer be able to consider late comments.

In certain instances, interested parties have written to EPA concerning sites, which were not at that time proposed to the NPL. If those sites are later proposed to the NPL parties should review their earlier concerns and, if still appropriate, resubmit those concerns for consideration during the formal comment period. Site-specific correspondence received prior to the period of formal proposal and comment will not generally be included in the docket.

A statement describing what information the Agency discloses in response to Freedom of Information Act requests from the public was published on February 25, 1987 [52 FR 5578].

#### V. Listing Policies

CERCLA restricts EPA's authority to respond to certain categories of releases and expressly excludes some substances from the definition of a release. In addition, as a matter of policy. EPA may choose not to use CERCLA to respond to certain types of releases because other authorities such as RCRA can be used to achieve cleanup of these releases. Preambles to previous NPL rulemakings have discussed examples of these deferral policies. (See 48 FR 40858 (September 2 1981); 49 FR 37070 (September 21, 1984); 49 FR 40220 (October 15, 1984); 51 FR 21056 (June 10, 1986); and \$2 FR 27520 (July 22, 1987)). In addition, EPA is considering broadening the deferral approach, such that listing of sites on the NPL would be deferred in cases where a Federal authority and its implementing program are found to have corrective action authority. EPA is also considering extending this policy to States that have implementing programs with cleanup authorities to address CERCIA releases, and to sites where the potentially responsible parties (PRPS) enter into Faderal enforcement agreements for site cleanup under CERCIA. EPA plans to propose this policy in the preamble to the NCP revisions which are scheduled for publication later in 1968. Sites included in today's proposed rule could be affected by that policy if, after public comment, it is adopted by EPA.

Sites proposed for the NPL in this update meet current criteria and listing policies. The NPL policies of relevance to this update—Federal facility sites. RCRA sites, special study waste sites, and mining sites—are discussed below.

Federal Facility Sites

On June 18, 1986 (51 FR 21057), the Agency announced a decision on components of a listing and deferral policy for non-Federal RCRA sites and requested comments on several additional components. The policy was intended to reflect RCRA's broadened corrective action authorities as a result of the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 [HSWA]. As explained in greater detail below, the policy generally defers the listing of sites subject to RCRA Subtitle C corrective action authorities unless one or more of three criteria is met: [1] The owner/operator is bankrupt [2] the owner/operator has lost authorization to operate and has indicated an unwillingness to undertake corrective action: or (3) in cases other than loss of authorization to operate, the owner/ operator has a clear history of unwillingness to undertake corrective action. In announcing this policy, the Agency reserved for a later date the question of whether this or another policy would be applicable for Federal facility sites. The Agency explained that this issue would be considered along with other issues relating to Federal facility sites (31 FR 22059, June 10, 1988).

Since that time, the Agency has considered the issue of placing Federal facility sites on the NPL As part of its deliberations. EPA considered pertinent sections of SARA and a policy published for comment regarding RCRA Subtitle C corrective action at Federal facilities with RCRA operating units (51 FR 7772. March & 1986). Specifically, that policy stated that: [1] RCRA section 2004(u) subjects Faderal facilities to corrective action requirements to the same extent as privately-owned or privately-operated facilities and (2) the

#### L Introduction

· in 1980. Congress enacted the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, 42 U.S.C. 9601. #t seq. ["CERCLA" or "the Act") in response to the dangers of uncontrolled hazardous waste sites. To implement CERCLA, the Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA" or the "Agency") promulgated the revised National Oil and Hazardous Substances Contingency Plan. 40 CFR Part 300, pn July 16, 1983 (47 FR 31180). pursuant to Section 105 of CERCLA and Executive Order 12316 (46 FR 42237. August 20, 1981). The National Contingency Plan ("NCP"), further revised by EPA on September 16, 1985 (50 FR 37624) and November 20, 1985 (50 FR 47912), sets forth the guidelines and procedures needed to respond under CERCLA to releases and threstened releases of hazardous substances. pollutants, or contaminants.

Section 105(a)(8)(A) of CERCLA, as amended, required that the NCP include criteria for determining priorities among releases or threatened releases for the purpose of taking remedial or removal action. Removal action involves cleanup or other actions that are taken in response to emergency conditions or on a short-term or temporary basis (CERCLA section 101(23)). Remedial action lends to be long-term in nature and involves response actions which are consistent with a permanent remedy for a release (CERCLA section 101(24)). These criteris are included in Appendix A of the NCP, Uncontrolled Hazardous Waste Site Ranking System: A User's Monual (the "Hazard Ranking System" or "HRS"] (47 FR 31219, July 18, 1982).

Section 105(a)(8)[8] of CERCLA, as amended, requires that the statutory criteria described in the HRS be used to prepare a list of national priorities among the known releases or threatened releases throughout the United States. The list, which is Appendix B of the NCP, is the National Priorities List ["NPL"].

in this notice. EPA is proposing to add 229 sites to the NPL In addition, four proposed sites are being reproposed and one final site is being proposed for expansion. Adding the 149 sites previously proposed brings the total number of proposed sites to 378. The final NPL contains 799 sites, for a total

issued prior to the enactment of the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) of 1984 and the owner/operator will not voluntarily modify the permit to incorporate corrective action requirements. Facilities in this category are referred to as pre-HSWA permittees. If a pre-HSWA permittee consents to include corrective action authority, EPA will consider not adding the facility to the NPL

. Update #7 includes eight RCRA rites meeting the inability to pay criterion. and 15 sites having converier or non- or late filer status. These sites are presented in Table 1. In addition. Update #7 includes generators. protective filers, and one pre-HSWA permittee, Solvent Service, Inc., San-Jose, CA. Sections 105(g) and 125 of CERCLA as amended by SARA, require additional information before sites involving RCRA "special study wastes" can be proposed for the NPL Section 105(g) applies to sites that (1) were not on or proposed for the NPL as of October 17, 1965, and (2) contain sufficient quantities of special study wastes as defined under sections 3001(b)(2), 3001(b)(3)(A)(ii), and 3001(b)(3)(A)(iii) of RCRA. Before these sites can be proposed for the NPL SARA requires that the following information be considered:

- The extent to which the HRS score for the facility is affected by the presence of the special study waste at or released from the facility.
- Available information as to the quantity, toxicity and concentration of hazardous substances that are constitutents of any special study waste at, or released from, the facility: the extent of or potential for release of such hazardous constituents: the exposure or polential exposure to human population and the environment, and the degree of hazard to human health or the environment posed by the release of such hazardous constitutents at the facility.

Section 125 of CERCLA, as amended. applies to facilities that were neither on nor proposed for the NPL on the date of enactment of SARA and which contain "subsigntial volumes" of waste described in section 3001[b][A](i) of RCRA. Until the HRS is revised, these sites may not be included on the NPL "on the basis of an evaluation made principally on the volume of such waste and not on the concentration of the hazzrdous constituents of such waste" Even though section 125 does not contain specific requirements for the interim period, the Agency believes that wastes covered reder section 125 should follow the requirements of section 105(g) antil these issues are addressed in the revised HRS.

To comply with SARA, the Agency has prepared addends that evaluate, for sacii proposed site containing or potentially containing special study wastes, the information called for in section 105(g). Section 125 addresses fly ash waste, bottom ash waste, alag waste, and five gas emission control waste, and not site in Update #7 has been surred using these special study wastes. Addenda are available for review in the public docket.

In summary, the Agency believes that placing Federal facility sites with or without RCRA units on the NPL is consistent with the intent of section 120 of SARA and will serve the purposes originally intended by the NCP at 40 CFR 300.66(e)(2)—to advise the public of the status of Federal government cleanup afforts (50 FR 47931, November 20, 1985). In addition, listing will help other Federal agencies set priorities and focus cleanup efforts on those sites presenting the most serious problems.

For Update #7, the Agency is proposing 14 Federal facility sites. bringing the total number of such proposed sites to 30. Of these 14 proposed sites, four are sub-areas of the Hanford site, the Department of Energy (DOE) facility in the State of Washington. The installation assessment for Hanford identified 337 potentially contaminated areas, and most of these have been aggregated into four larger areas termed the 100, 200, 300 and 1100 areas. Each of these four larger areas has been evaluated and each is being proposed for the NPL

Releases From Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Sites

On June 10, 1988 (51 FR 21057), EPA announced a decision on components of a policy for the listing or the deferral from listing on the NPL of several categories of potential RCRA sites. At the same time, the Agency requested comment on several other components of the NPL/RCRA policy (51 FR 21109).

Under the policy, sites not subject to RCRA Subtitle C corrective action authorities will continue to be placed on the NPL Examples of such sites include:

 Facilities that ceased treating, storing. or disposing of hazardous waste prior to November 19, 1980 (the effective date of Phase I of the Subtitle C regulations).

 Sites at which only materials exempted from the statutory or regulatory definition of solid waste or hazardous waste are managed.

 Hazardous waste generators or transporters which are not required to have interim Status or a final RCRA

Also under the policy, certain RCRA sites at which Subutle C corrective action authorities are available may also be listed if they meet the criteria for listing (e.g., an HRS score of 28.50 or greater) and they fall within one of the following categories:

(1) Facilities owned by persons who have demonstrated an inability to

p as evidenced by finance a cl their invocation of the bankruptcy Isws.

(2) Facilities that have lost authorization to operate, and for which there are additional indications that the owner or operator will be unwilling to undertake corrective action.

(3) Sites, analyzed on a case-by-case basis, whose owners or operators have a clear history of unwillingness to undertake corrective action.

Elsewhere in today's Federal Register, the Agency has described in greater detail several other categories of RCRA sites which it considers appropriate for the NPL One category is non- or late filers. These are facilities that were treating, storing, or disposing of hazardous waste after November 19. 1980, but did not file a Part A permit by that date and have little or no history of compliance with RCRA. EPA has found that breatment, storage, and disposal facilities (TSDFs) that fail to file Part A of the RCRA permit application generally remain outside the range of cognizance of authorities responsible for compliance with RCRA, and generally are without the institutional mechanisms such as ground water monitoring programs, necessary to assure prompt compliance with the standards and goals of the RCRA ргодталь

Another category of RCRA sites appropriate for listing is converters (the rationale for which is discussed elsewhere in today's Federal Register). These are facilities that at one time were beating or storing RCRA Subtitle C hazardous waste but have since converted to generator-only status, or any other hazardous waste activity for which interim status is not required. Their Part A applications have been withdrawn. This category is considered appropriate for listing because the RCRA corrective action program currently focuses primarily on TSDFs (due to statutory deadlines in RCRA). and thus EPA has not routinely reviewed converters under RCRA Subtitle C. Therefore, EPA has decided to propose these sites in order to ensure .

that they are expeditiously addressed. Two other categories of RCRA sites are appropriate for the NPL because the sites are not subject to Subtitle C corrective action authorities of RCRA. The protective filer category includes facilities which have filed Part A permit applications for beatment storage and disposal of hazardous wastes as a precautionary measure only. The second eategory includes facilities for which permits for the treatment, storage, or dispossi of hazardous waste were

associated with this revision are senerally similar to those identified in the regulatory impact analysis [RIA] prepared in 1982 for the revisions to the NCP pursuant to section 105 of CERCLA [47 FR 31180, July 18, 1982] and the aconomic analysis prepared when the amendments to the NCP were proposed (50 FR 5887, February 12, 1985). The Agency believes the anticipated economic effects related to proposing the addition of these sites to the MPL can be characterized in terms of the conclusions of the earlier RIA and the most recent economic analysis. This rule was submitted to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for review as requested by Executive Order No. 12291.

#### Costs

EPA has determined that this proposed rulemaking is not "major" regulation under Executive Order No. 12291 because inclusion of a site on the NPL does not itself impose any costs. It does not establish that EPA will necessarily undertake remedial action, nor does it require any action by a private party or determine its liability for alte response costs. Costs that arise out of site responses result from site-by-site decisions about what actions to take, not directly from the act of listing itself. Nonetheless, it is useful to consider the costs associated with responding to all sites included in a proposed rulemaking. This action was submitted to the Office of Management and Budget for review.

The major events that generally follow the proposed listing of a site on the NPL are a search for responsible parties and a remedial investigation/feasibility study (RI/FS) to determine if remedial actions will be undertaken at a site. Design and construction of the selected remedial alternative follow completion of the RI/FS, and operation and maintenance (O&M) activities may continue after construction has been completed.

Costs associated with responsible party searches are initially borne by EPA. Responsible parties may bear some or all the costs of the RI/FS, design and construction, and O&M, or the costs may be shared by EPA and the States.

The State cost share for cleanup activities has been amended by section 104 of SARA. For privately-owned sites, as well as publicly-owned but not publicly-operated sites. EPA will pay for 100% of the costs of the RI/FS and remedial planning, and 20% of the costs associated with remedial action. The State will be responsible for 10% of the remedial action costs. For publicly-operated sites, the State cost share is at

least 50% of all response costs, including the RI/FS, remedial design and construction, and O&M.

With regard to O&M for cleanup activities other than ground water or surface water. EPA will share, for up to 1 year, in the cost of that portion of O&M that is necessary to assure that a remedy is operational and functional. After that time, the State assumes full responsibility for O&M. SARA provides that EPA will share in the operational cost associated with ground water/aurface water restoration for up to 10 years.

in previous NPL rulemakings, the Agency has provided estimates of the costs associated with these activities [RI/FS, remedial design, remedial action, and O&M) on an average per site and total cost basis. At this time. however, there is insufficient information to determine what these posts will be as a result of the new requirements under SARA. Until such information is available, the Agency will provide cost estimates based on CERCLA prior to enactment of SARA; these estimates are presented below. EPA is unable to predict that portions of the total costs will be borne by responsible parties, since the distribution of costs depends on the extent of voluntary and negotiated response and the success of any costrecovery actions.

Costs to States associated with today's proposed amendment arise from the required State cost-share of: (1) 10% of remedial actions and 10% of first-year D&M costs at privately-owned sites and sites which are publicly-owned but not publicly-operated; and (2) at least 50% of the remedial planning (RI/PS and remedial design), remedial action\_and arst-year O&M costs at publiclyoperated sites. States will assume the report for D&M after EPA's period-of participation. Using the assumptions . developed in the 1982 RIA for the NCP. -EPA has assumed that 90% of the 215 zon-Federal situs proposed for the NPL in this amendment will be privatelyowned and 10% will be State- or locallyoperated. Therefore, using the budget

projections presented above, the cost to States of andertaking Federal remedial actions at all 215 non-Federal sites would be approximately \$1.02 billion, of which approximately 744 million is attributable to the State O&M cost. As a result of the changes to State cost share under SARA, however, the Agency-believes that State O&M costs may actually decrease. When new cost information is available, it will be presented in future rulemakings.

Proposing a hazardous waste site for the NPL does not itself cause firms responsible for the site to bear costs. Nonetheless, a listing may induce firms to clean up the site voluntarily, or it may act as a potential trigger for subsequent enforcement or cost-recovery actions. Such actions may impose costs on firms, but the decisions to take such actions are discretionary and made on a caseby-case basis. Consequently, precise estimates of these effects cannot be made. EPA does not believe that every site will be cleaned up by a responsible party. EPA cannot project at this time which firms or industry sectors will bear specific portions of response costs, but the Agency considers: the volume and nature of the wastes at the site, the parties' ability to pay, and other factors when deciding whether and how to proceed against potentially responsible parties.

Economy-wide effects of this proposed amendment are aggregations of effects on firms and State and local governments. Although effects could be felt by some individual firms and States, the total impact of this revision on output, prices, and employment is expected to be negligible at the national level, as was the case in the 1962 RIA.

#### Benefits

The benefits associated with today's proposed amendment to list additional sites are increased health and environmental protection as a result of increased public awareness of potential hazards. In addition to the potential for more Federally-financed remedial actions, this proposed expension of the NPL-could accelerate privately-financed voluntary cleanup efforts to avoid potential adverse publicity, private iswauits, and/or Federal or State anforcement actions.

As a result of the additional NPL remedies, there will be lower human exposure to high-risk chemicals, and higher-quality surface water, ground water, soil, and air. These benefits are expected to be significant, although difficult to estimate in advance of completing the RI/FS at these particular sites.

· Weldon Spring Quarry (USDOE/ Army), St. Charles County, MO. This Federal facility site was placed on the final NPL on July 22, 1987 [52 FR 27620). Since then, EPA has determined that the Weldon Spring Feed Materials Plant and Raffmate Pits, located less than three miles from the Quarry, are linked to the contamination problems at the original site. Cossequently, EPA proposes to expend the original site and requests comment on the expanded site. The new site will be renamed "Weldon Spring Quarry! Plant/Pits (USDOE/Army).

## VI. Contents of the Proposed Seventh NPL Update

Following this preamble is a list of the 229 sites proposed for the NPL. See Table 2 and Table 3. Each entry on the list contains the name of the facility and the State and city or county in which it is located. All aires other than NW. Mauthe Co., Appleton, WL received HRS scores of 18.50 or above. NW. Mauthe is the State top priority site, and received an HRS score of 25.35.

Each proposed .... is placed by score in a group corresponding to groups of 30 sites presented within the Smal HPL For example, sites in Group & of the proposed spoats have scores that fall within the range of scores sovered by the eighth group of 30 sites on the final NPL Any site designated by a State as its top priority is included within the one hundred highest priority sites. as provided by section 105(a)(8)(B) of CERCLA, as amended. Since States are not required to rely exclusively on the HRS is designating their top priority sites, lower scoring State priority sites such as N.W. Mauthe are listed at the bottom of the first one hundred sites on the MPL

Each entry is accompanied by one or more notations reflecting the status of response and cleanup activities at the site at the time this list was prepared. Because this information may change periodically, these notations may become outdated.

Five response categories are used to designate the type of response underway. One or more categories may apply to each site. The categories are: Federal and/or State response [R]. Federal enforcement [F]. State enforcement [S]. Voluntary or negotiated response [V], and Category to be determined [D].

EPA also indicates the status of significant Fund-linenced or privateparty cleanup activities underway or completed at proposed and final NPL sites. There are three cleanup status codes; only one code is necessary to designate the status of cleanup activities at each site since the codes are mutually exclusive. The codes are: Implementation activities are underway for one or more operable units (I). implementation activities are completed for one or more (but not all) operable units, but additional site cleanup scrions are necessary (O), and implementation activities are completed for all operable units (C)

These categories and codes are explained in detail in earlier rulemakings, most recently on June 10. 1988 (51 FR 21075).

# VII. Regulatory Impact Analysis

The costs of cleanup actions that may be taken at sites are not directly attributable to listing on the NPL as explained below. Therefore, the Agency has determined that this releviating is not a "major" regulation under Executive Order No. 12331. EPA has conducted a preliminary analysis of the economic implications of today's proposal to add new sites. EPA believes that the kinds of economic affects

Proposing s for the NPL does not in itself uire any action by any private party. does it determine the liability of any ty for the cost of cleanup at the zite.

Further, so identifiable groups are affected as a whole. As a consequence, it is bard to predict impacts on any group. A site's proposed inclusion on the NPL could increase the likelihood that adverse impacts to responsible parties (in the form of cleamp costs) will occur. but EPA carnot identify the potentially effected businesses at this time nor estimate the number of small businesses that might be affected.

The Agency does expect that certain industries and firms within Industries that have caused a proportionately high percentage of waste site problems could be significantly affected by CERCLA actions. However, EPA does not expect the impacts from the proposed listing of these sites to have a significant economic impact on a substantial number of small businesses.

In any case, economic impacts would only occur through anforcement and cost-recovery actions, which are taken at EPA's discretion on a site-by-site basis. EPA considers many factors when determining what enforcement actions to take, including the firm's contribution

... to the problem and the firm's ability to pay. The impacts from cost recovery on -amail governments and nonprofit organizations would be determined on a almiles case-by-case basis.
