Dear Mr. Butler:

I have completed review of Kenneky/Jenks Consultants' November 2000 *Phase II Environmental Site Assessment* (ESA) report prepared for the above referenced site. Field work for the ESA was completed in August 2000. The purpose of the ESA was to assess potential fuel release from the operation of three former underground storage tanks (USTs) at the site. The former USTs were reportedly removed in 1986.

Three soil borings were advanced, using a hydraulic push/drive sampling system, adjacent to the former USTs. Soil and grab groundwater samples were collected for total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg), TPH as diesel, benzene, toluene, ethyl-benzene, and xylenes (BTEX), and MTBE analyses. Soil and groundwater analytical results did not reveal remarkable levels of analytes sought. It appears that any fuel release related to the former USTs at the site was not significant. Based upon the available information and with the provision that the information provided to this agency was accurate and representative of site conditions, no further action related to the former USTs is required.

Please be aware that further work may be required if conditions change or a water quality threat is discovered at this specific site.
