He may be able to get DS values from adjacent Navy site.

PHONE LOG (MARINER DEVELOPMENT)

2/1/95

John Bird, Versar, 814-5929

Mr. Bird is a consultant for investigations currently being conducted on the Navy property, located adjacent to the Mariner Development site. I requested a copy of the RI Report recently prepared for the Navy site, so that I could review the overall regional problem w/ TPH & PNA's in the tidal channels. According to Mr. Bird, the Navy prop. and Mariner Development did not exist when area was marshlands, prior to filling.

At that time, the marshlands were used for gas manufacturing and refineries. The Mariner and Navy properties were only created subsequent to this w/ fill.

Mr. Bird feels that there is preferential flow along the old tidal channels, & could be flowing in different directions than the regional gradient. Also, he feels that pumping at the Webster Tube may be influencing gradient. According to Mr. Bird, there is no pumping currently on the Navy property. Mr. Bird has let the Navy know that the County wants a copy of the RI. The Navy contact is Ernie Galang (415) 244-2560.

Ernie Galang called & said the RI should be finalized in April & that he would mail the County a copy at that time.
