This letter summarizes the issues we discussed at the meeting held at the Hayward City Hall on March 12, 1992. AM Homes is proposing to sell this 32-acre Hayward parcel to Pepsi-Cola Company. Pepsi is planning to develop this property into a bottling and wearhouse facility.

This Office has studied the technical report prepared by Lowney Associates and is satisfied with the manner in which the site assessment was conducted. Additionally, the soil leachablity tests performed in this study also indicate no potential threat to the ground water under the existing conditions.

This office is also in receipt of the letter from Dyana Anderly, Associate Planner, City of Hayward; the city of Hayward has zoned this location as industrial in nature.

Based on all presently available data, this Office feels that the property can be developed by Pepsi as intended. However, please be aware that further action (investigation and cleanup) may be required if information received subsequent to this letter indicates a need for it.
