Dear Mr. Ellis:

This letter confirms the completion of site investigation and remedial action for the soil contaminated with chlorinated solvents at the former Hi Hat Cleaners facility located at the above referenced address.

An environmental assessment conducted in May 1993 identified staining on the floor of the dry cleaners facility, particularly in the vicinity of the area which housed the dry cleaning machine and the solvent distallation unit. In August 1993 three hand-augered borings were drilled within the stained areas. Soil samples collected at one foot and three foot depths identified up to 2.4 parts per million tetrachloroethene (PCE).

In May 1995 contaminated soil was excavated to a depth of 5'bgs from two locations. A confirmatory soil sample was collected from each excavation. In addition, soil gas sampling (using Summa canisters) was also conducted. Laboratory analyses did not identify detectable concentrations of chlorinated hydocarbons/PCE in the soil and gas samples.

Information gleaned from Alan Kropp & Associates' May 27, 1993 Geotechnical Investigation report suggested that depth to groundwater at the site is expected to be in excess of 50'bgs. Fractured sandstone and serpentine underlay the asphalt and concrete cover. For this reason a groundwater investigation was not required.

Based upon the available information and with the provision that — the information provided to this agency was accurate and representative of site conditions, no further action related to the surface contamination by chlorinated hydrocarbons is required.
