Dear Mr. Cohen:

I have completed review of Gribi Associates' (Gribi) May 1999 Workplan to Conduct Soil and Groundwater Investigation prepared for the above referenced site. Gribi proposes to advance three soil borings using direct-push technology to assess whether the past operation of the Chevron Car Wash's underground storage tanks (USTs) has impacted soil and/or groundwater at the site. This proposal is acceptable with the following additions/changes:

• A review of Sanborn Maps indicated the presence of a former gas station and auto body/repair shop at the north half of the property. It appears a previous water sample may have been obtained in this vicinity. The existing onsite well should be located and sounded to determine if the well is a groundwater monitoring well that is screened in the first encountered groundwater. If water from this well is not representative of first water, then a soil boring should also be advanced in the vicinity of the suspect USTs for the collection and analysis of soil and groundwater samples. In addition to analysis for TPHg, BTEX, and MTBE, please include analysis for chlorinated solvents in these samples.
