Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) and California Regional Water Quality Control Board staff have reviewed the fuel leak case file and case closure summary for the above-referenced site and concur that no further action related to the underground storage tank fuel release is required at this time. Prior to issuance of Remedial Action Completion Certification, the monitoring wells at the site are to be properly decommissioned, should the monitoring wells have no further use at the site. Please decommission the monitoring wells and provide documentation of the well decommissioning to this office. A Remedial Action Completion Certificate will be issued following receipt of the documentation.
