Subject: Comingled Plume Account

Dear Ms. Reid,

I have two sites under consideration for the Comingled Plume Account (CPA). They are the Shell facility located at 1601 Webster St. and the former Unocal facility located at 1629 Webster St., both in Alameda, California. The two responsible parties for the sites, Equilon Enterprises (Shell) and Chevron (Unocal), in CPA claim no. CP0064 are in compliance with Alameda County Environmental Health directives. The Unocal site is preparing a pilot study work plan to evaluate the effectiveness of ozone injection for reducing residual chemical concentrations. The work plan is to be submitted by April 16, 2012. The former Unocal site is currently vacant. The site is undergoing quarterly groundwater monitoring to gather baseline information prior to anticipated work plan implementation. The Shell facility continues as an active service station and is undergoing semi-annual monitoring. The semi-annual monitoring events for the Shell site are coordinated with the Chevron site.
