Mr. Rob Weston of ACDEH Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA) has informed me the tank removal/replacement activities are scheduled for May 16, 2014. Tank removal activities will be postponed pending ACDEHs receipt of, and approval of, the well protection report.
