

Meeting of 11-24-86 with Dick Dugely, Tom Mahon and myself.

We went over the clean-up proposal^a drawn up by Gretchen Hayes, Sales Account Mgr. for I.T. Corp. Ms. Hayes called earlier that morning to inform me she could not attend our meeting, but could be paged by calling her office at (415) 372-5227. She told me I.T. charges \$3500/hr. for a Tech, \$38-5000/hr. for a supervisor, plus the equipment.

Before meeting with Dugely and Mahon, I went over I.T. Corp. proposal with Rosa. We agreed the proposal was reasonable. I informed Dugely & Mahon, if they like, they could take out 1 foot of soil from the^{side} bottom of the jet and then take a core sample. Also, they could leave the drain line from the gauge to the jet if it's flushed out thoroughly, and soil sample around the pipe indicates no contamination. As far ~~as~~ as the disposal of the drum liquid at the site and sampling of the septa tank, ~~it was~~ it was straight forward.

We meet to discuss the clean-up proposal drawn up by Roger Wagner of Erickson. He did not have anything in writing and just gave us a verbal proposal with no estimate of total cost. He said he would have a written proposal with an estimate by early next week. He said that Chips Environmental would work with him at the clean-up site using their mobil laboratory. They could check samples at the site for approx. \$1,000/day. He also proposed taking not only samples from the septic tank, but also the ~~area~~ surrounding beach field.
