Request for Site Closure Laguna Oaks Site Pleasanton, California

BACKGROUND

Yesterday a meeting was held between Mr. Ravi Arulanathan of Alameda County and Messrs. Arshud Mahmood and Mike Gemmell of Dames & Moore. At this meeting, Dames & Moore's Laguna Oaks site characterization report dated July 31, 1992 was discussed. We understand that Mr. Arulanathan is in general agreement with the report conclusions regarding the nature and extent of PCE contamination. It is our understanding that the site characterization is considered adequate, showing that the extent of PCE contamination is minor.

At this meeting, Dames & Moore was requested to submit a site closure request for consideration by Alameda County. This request is presented in the following paragraphs.

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of the letter is to present the evidence and rationale from our recent investigations at Laguna Oaks site in Pleasanton, California that lead us to recommend site closure at this time.

The Laguna Oaks site in Pleasanton, California is located on a 680 acre parcel on Foothill Road just north of Bernal Avenue, approximately 1/2 mile west of the 680 freeway. The site was previously used as a dairy farm until 1969, and is currently unused awaiting development.

During removal of an on-site underground storage tank (UST) containing gasoline in 1989, evidence of tank leakage was found. Subsequently, low levels of TPH and BTEX were found in monitoring wells installed around the former tank location. Following an initial round of groundwater sampling in March 1990, an anomaly was detected in the laboratory reports. Subsequent sampling indicated the presence of PCE in monitoring wells MW-2 and 3. Investigations to delineate the contamination included a soil gas survey, and a recent field program (July 1992) which included: a geophysical survey to locate underground lines which might be the source of PCE, a trenching program to follow up the geophysical results, and a drilling program to further delineate the PCE and gasoline components in groundwater.

The results of these investigations indicate the following.

- PCE and gasoline components (TPH and BTEX) are restricted to a small area of the site;
- PCE has apparently entered the subsurface underneath an underground utility line excavated during trenching;
- The contamination is restricted to a perched water zone less than 25 feet thick of low permeability sediments;
- The perched water zone is not connected with any underlying regional aquifers as evidenced by unsaturated samples collected at the bottom of several borings;

- The water-bearing zone is not a potential aquifer due to its low permeability; and
- Conventional remediation such as pump and treat is not viable due to the low permeability of the perched water-bearing zone.

In view of the above, we request that the site should be considered closed, with the stipulation that there is no significant change in the above conditions. The conditions will be monitored on a quarterly basis for the next year and on a semiannual basis during the following year.

We also request that a letter be issued, affirming your agreement with the following items:

- 1. Based on the site characterization results, the PCE contamination at the Laguna Oaks site is limited to a small, defined zone of perched water.
- 2. Based on the monitoring results to date, the likelihood of the spread of the PCE contamination is very low.
- 3. If continued monitoring detects no spread of contamination, the County of Alameda or the Regional Water Quality Control Board is not going to require remediation.
