This letter is to notify your agency of intended subterranean work, beginning on September 19, 2008 and extending to October 16, 2008, as required by the subject property deed restriction. Work will be performed in accordance with the Health and Safety Plan (HASP) being completed by EKI, the tenant environmental consultant. Novartis Pharmaceuticals, the tenant, will submit the HASP to Stellar Environmental Solutions, who will in turn forward the HASP to Alameda County Department of Environmental Health prior to the project initiation.

The nature of this work is to install a new glass washer as part of a technical services upgrade project. To complete the necessary sub-grade piping, a cut will be made into the building slab, and an excavation measuring approximately 100 liner feet in length, 2 feet to 6 feet in width, and to a maximum depth of 3 feet will be made into the ground surface.
