Dear Ms. Duffy:

This letter confirms the completion of site investigation and remedial action for the soil contaminated with volatile organic compounds (chlorobenzene, 1,2-dichlorobenzene, 1,3-DCB, and 1,4-DCB) at the above referenced address. Affected soil was removed from beneath the concrete slab of the former warehouse structure.

In addition, residual gasoline-impacted soil (due to a former leaking underground storage tank removed in 1986) was removed. Soils containing trace TPH as gasoline and benzene are not hazardous and do not appear to pose a risk to human health, therefore, will not require any remediation, special handling, or restriction of use onsite.

Based upon the available information and with the provision that the information provided to this agency was accurate and representative of site conditions, no further action related to the soil contamination by TPHg and VOCs is required.
