

Dear Ms. Barsamian:

By the present letter FMC Corporation (FMC) is providing notice under Task B.4. and requesting an extension from September 1, 1999 to March 1, 2000 relative to submittal of the report on "Proposed Final Remedial Actions and Cleanup Standards" ("Remedial Alternatives Report") required under Task B.3. of the State of California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (RWQCB) Order No. 98-066, "Revision of Site Cleanup Requirements and Rescission of Order No. 89-055 for: FMC Corporation, 8787 Enterprise Drive, Newark, California." The Regional Board adopted Order No. 98-066 on July 15, 1998.

This extension is requested due to delays experienced in undertaking the remedial investigation and submittal of the Remedial Investigation Report. For reasons outlined in a March 5, 1999 request for extension of the date for submittal of the Remedial Investigation Report, there was a delay of approximately two and half

months (from April 1, 1999 to June 15, 1999) in submittal of the RI Report. In addition, FMC has not yet received an approval letter or even any comments from the RWQCB with respect to the RI Report. FMC will submit the Remedial Alternatives Report to the RWQCB by March 1, 2000 if approval of the RI Report has been received by August 31, 1999, which provides FMC sufficient time (approximately 180 days from the approval of the RI Report) to prepare the Remedial Alternatives Report.

If this is a matter, which Executive Officer can handle, please do so. Otherwise, please present this request for an extension to the Regional Board at its next meeting.



Alameda County Public Health Department, Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has established a deposit refund mechanism to recover costs incurred by departmental staff for regulatory oversight of sites undergoing environmental investigation or cleanup activities. A tally of hours previously spent by EPD staff on this project indicates that 19.5 staff hours were spent on this project from our initial meeting on February 26, 1996 through the Review Panel meeting on May 22, 1996. Alameda County currently charges \$ 90.00 per hour. Fees to date total \$1755.00. It is anticipated that the characterization of soil and groundwater beneath the stockpiled material described above will require additional EPD staff time for regulatory oversight.
