Dear Mr. Gilmore,

This office has received and reviewed Versar's Quarterly Ground Water Sampling Report, dated March 12, 1993, which included a detailed description of the most recent investigations at the site involving the sampling of six soil borings. In this report, Versar recommends the installation of an upgradient monitoring well and remediation of the soil contamination. This office finds these recommendations acceptable. In addition to Versar's recommendations, however, this office is requiring that a monitoring well be placed downgradient of Boring B-9, due to the fact that ground water samples recently collected from this boring identified 2,000 ppb Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons as gasoline, and 620 ppb Benzene.

Additionally, quarterly ground water monitoring should continue, with the inclusion of lead analysis as part of the sampling events.

Please be reminded that prior to any further work at the site, a work plan detailing the proposed work shall be submitted to this office for our review and approval.
