Our records indicate that underground tanks are or were in place at the above noted site. You are requested to investigate your underground storage tank site records to determine the current status of this facility. This review should focus on the following points:

1. Dates on which the tanks, if removed, were taken out.
2. Manner of disposal of tanks and any contaminated soil.
3. Remedial action taken as a result of any leaks in the underground storage tanks.
