Dear Mr. Fernandez:

As you're aware, on November 7, 1989, one underground storage tank was removed from the above facility, and soil samples were collected and analyzed according to guidelines established by the San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board. GTEL Laboratories analyzed the samples and reported hydrocarbon levels of 24 ppm in one and "ND" in the other. Contaminated excavation spoils were hauled under manifest to GSX in McKittrick, CA.

Based on the information outlined above, no further site remediation is needed at this time. Please be aware that this does not free present or future landowners or operators from cleanup responsibilities in the event that new information indicates a pollutant problem on the site or originating from the site.
