Subject: Directions to ERM-West

Steven, the best way to get here is to catch 980 to 24 towards Sacramento. When you get to the point that you either need to go north or south on I-680 from 24, veer toward the south direction, and the first exit before you get to 680 (it's actually a left exit onto Mt. Diablo Blvd.) takes you straight into Walnut Creek. Don't make the mistake of taking the Mt. Diablo exit in Lafayette, because although it's the same road they don't really connect very easily.

After getting off at the correct Mt. Diablo exit, you'll go to the third stoplight - past St. Mary's church on the right. The third stoplight is Alpine. Go right and follow it through the next light, which will be Olympic. After going through the light, you'll notice I-680 south on your right. Alpine will curve to the left at Botelho, and the cream-colored building on the right is our building (1777 Botelho Drive). Turn into the parking garage - we'll get your ticket validated - and park on the first level (P-1); take the elevator (or stairs if you need the exercise) up to the second floor and we're the suite at the top of the landing (260). We'll be waiting for you.
